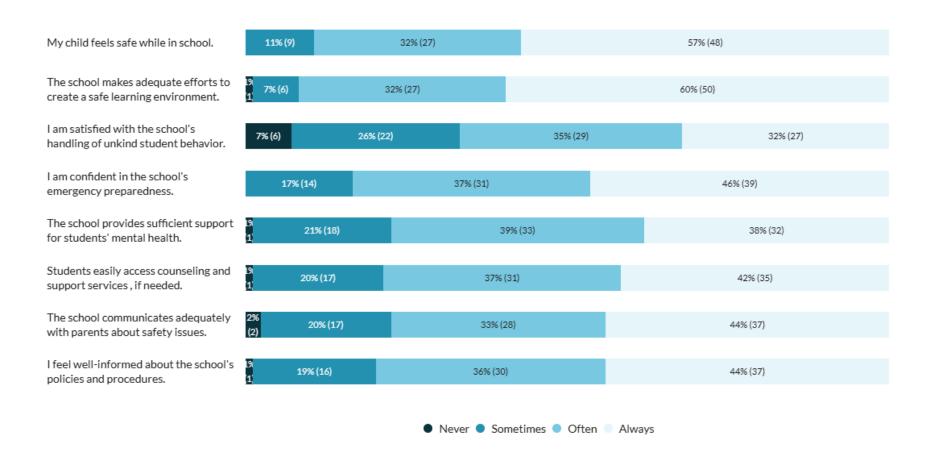

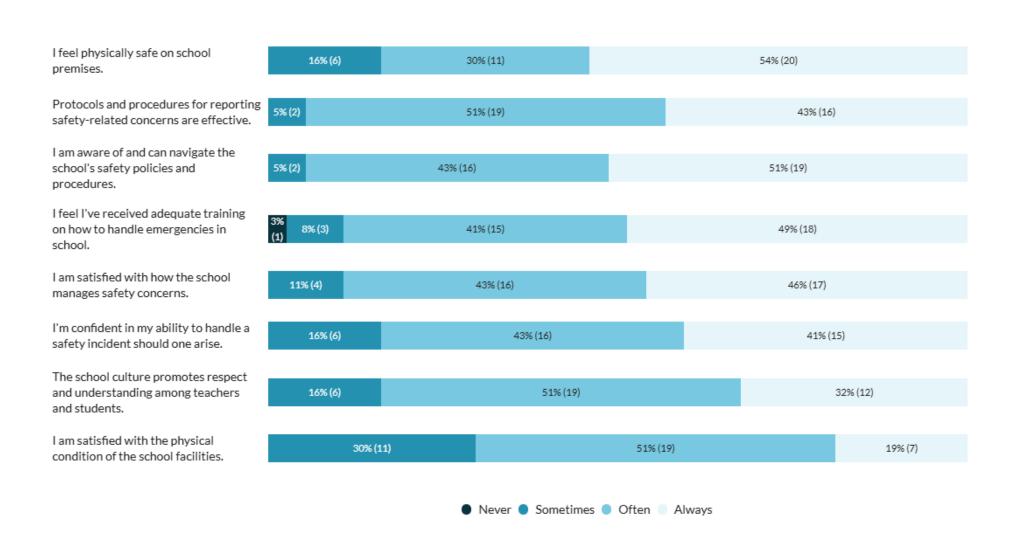

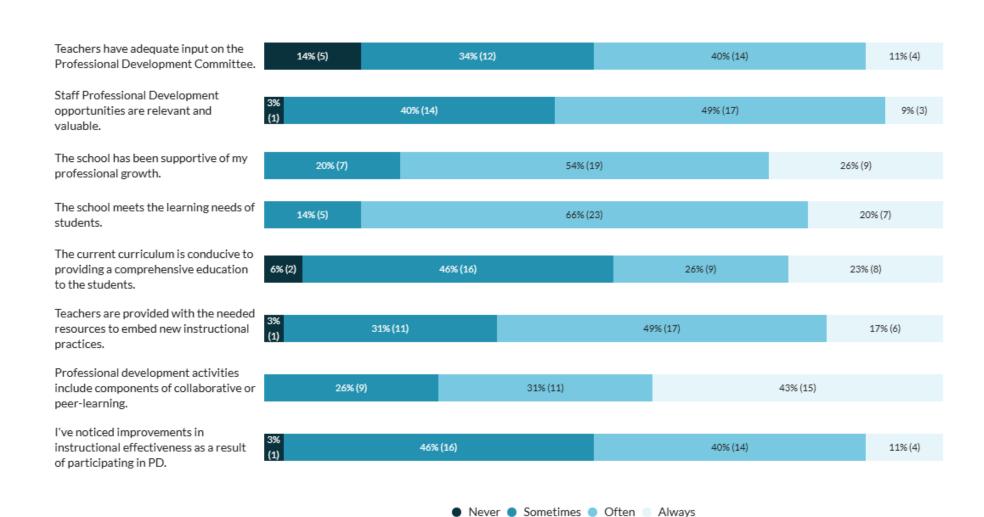
### Q9-16 Perception of Personal and School Safety

### Plymouth Center School Climate Survey Themes & 2025-2026 Focus Areas

\* Since no student survey was conducted at Plymouth Center School, the third area of focus has been developed using a combination of faculty and parent survey results. \*

#### Parent Survey -

#### Area of Focus Survey Evidence -

- Area of Focus: Improve the management of challenging student behaviors.

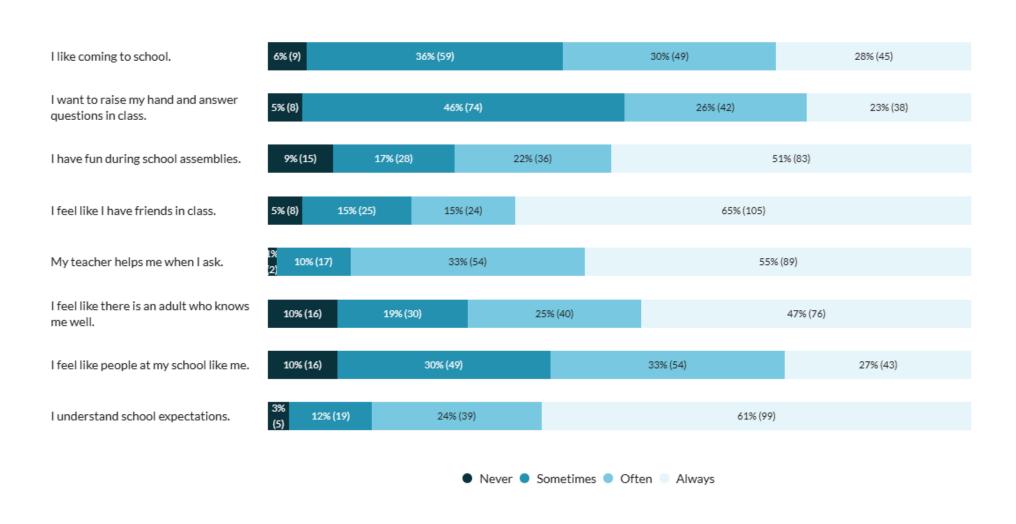

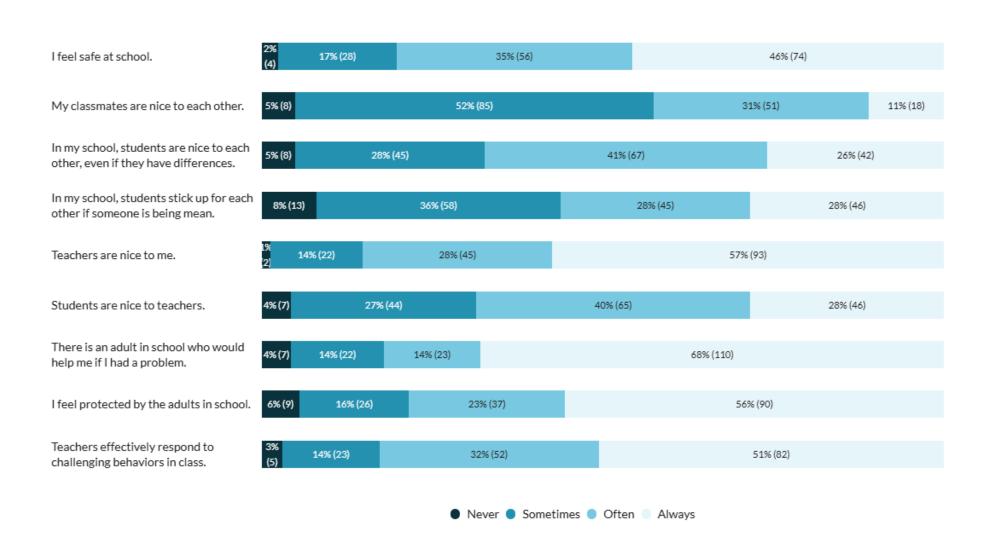

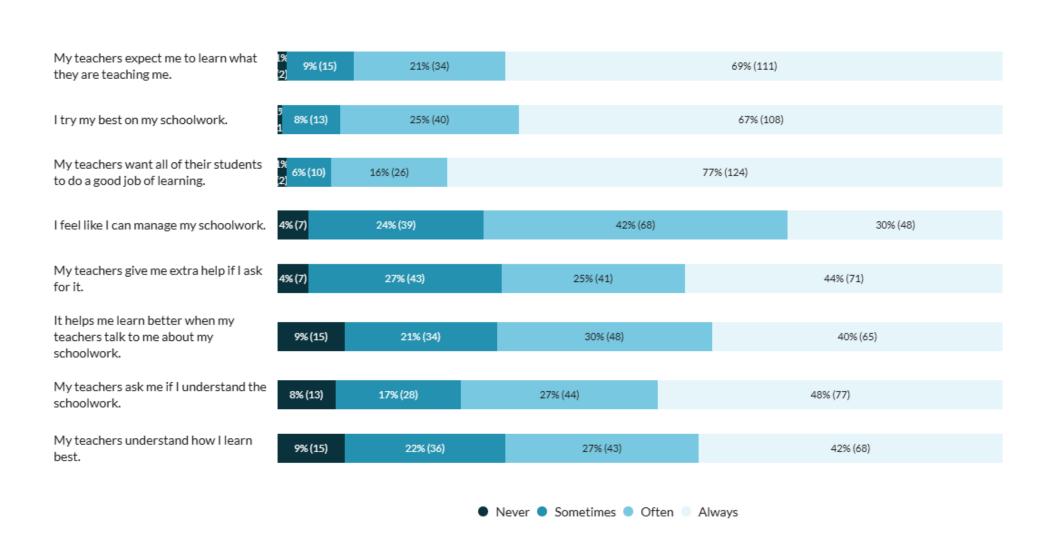
### Q9-17 Perception of Personal and School Safety

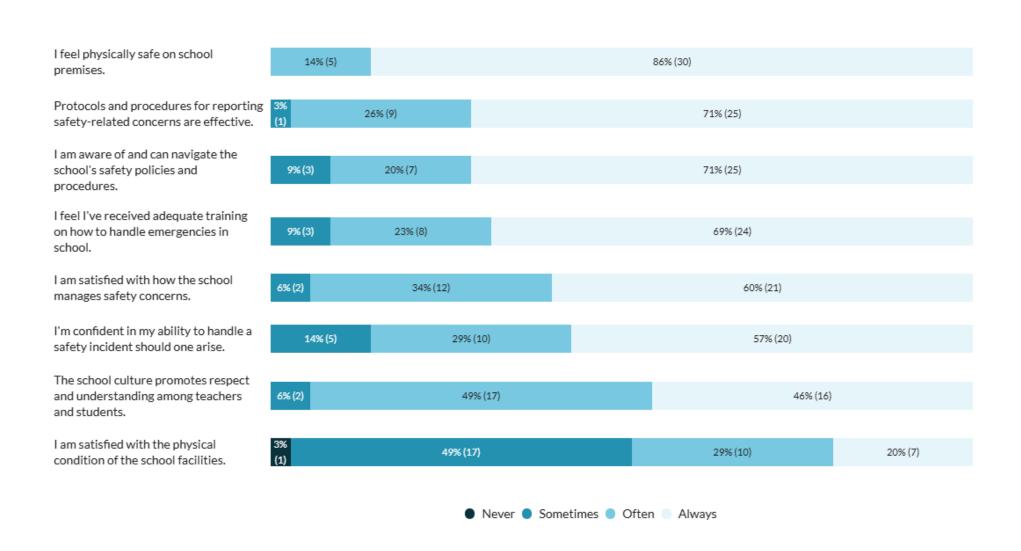

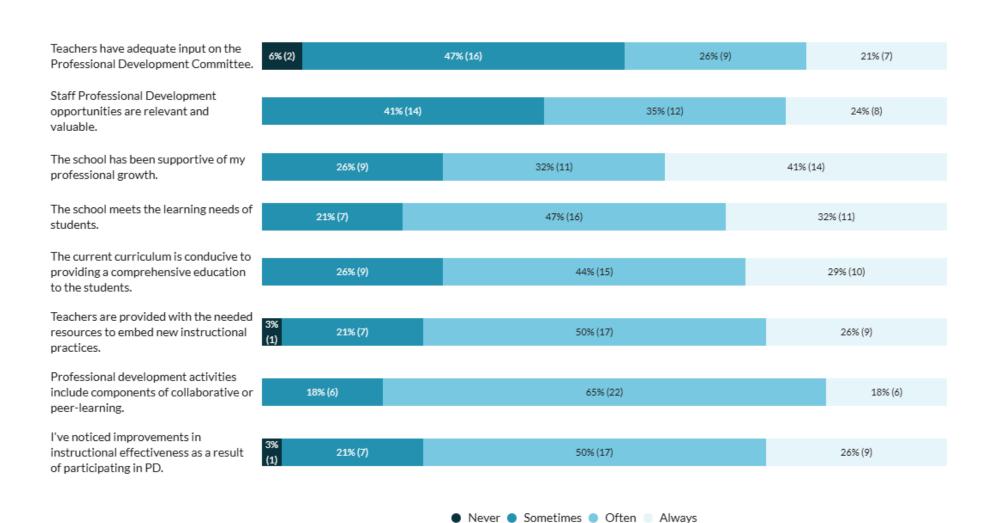

- **Area of Focus:** Improve staff input on professional development as to improve the perceived relevance and value of professional development provided.

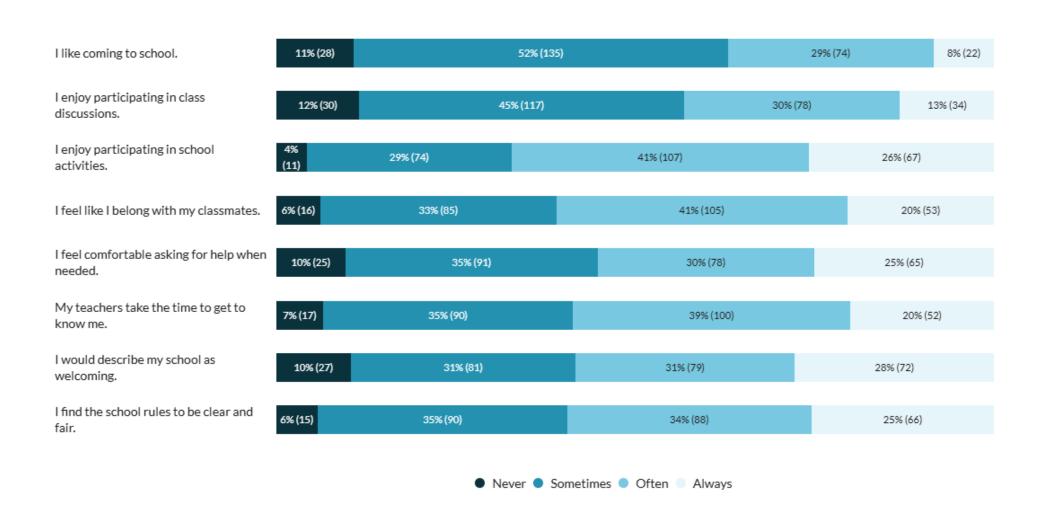

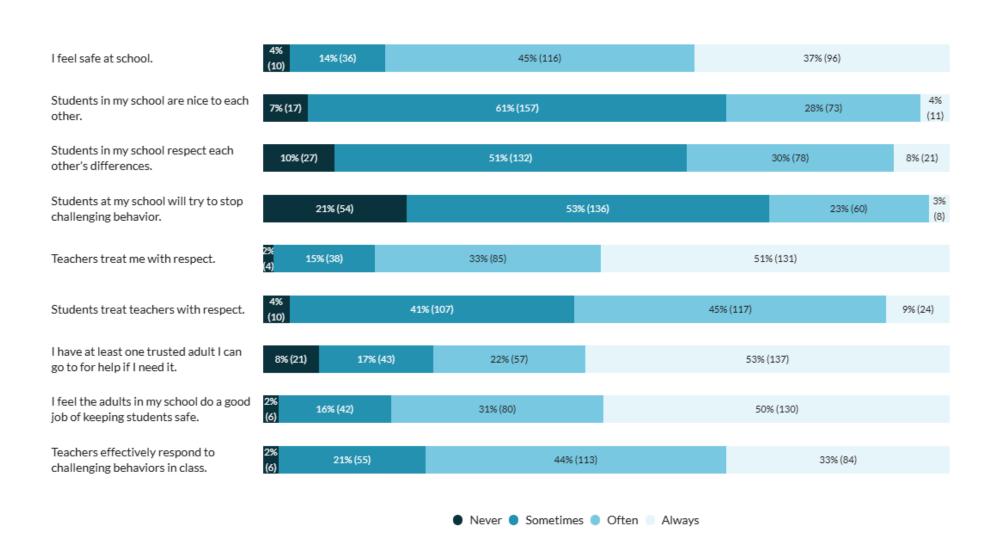

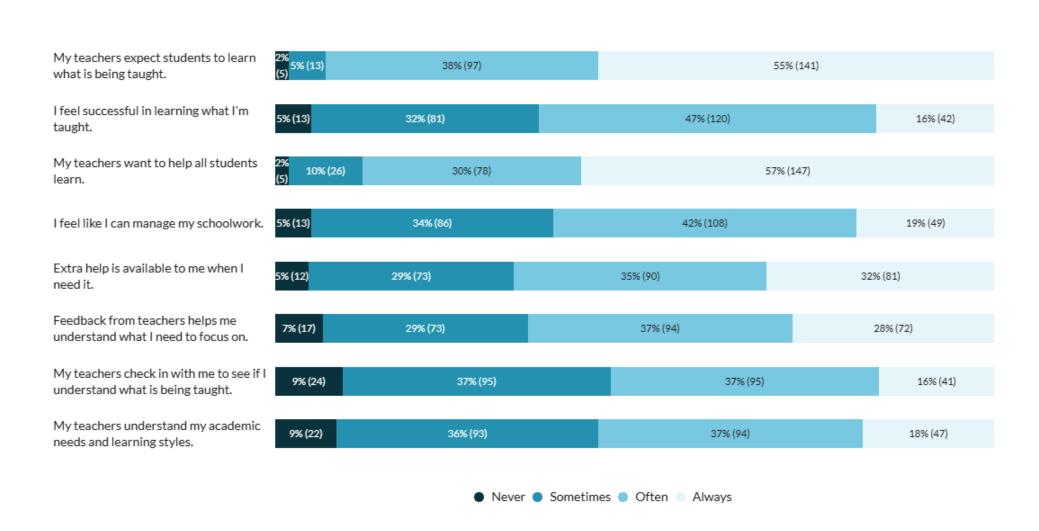

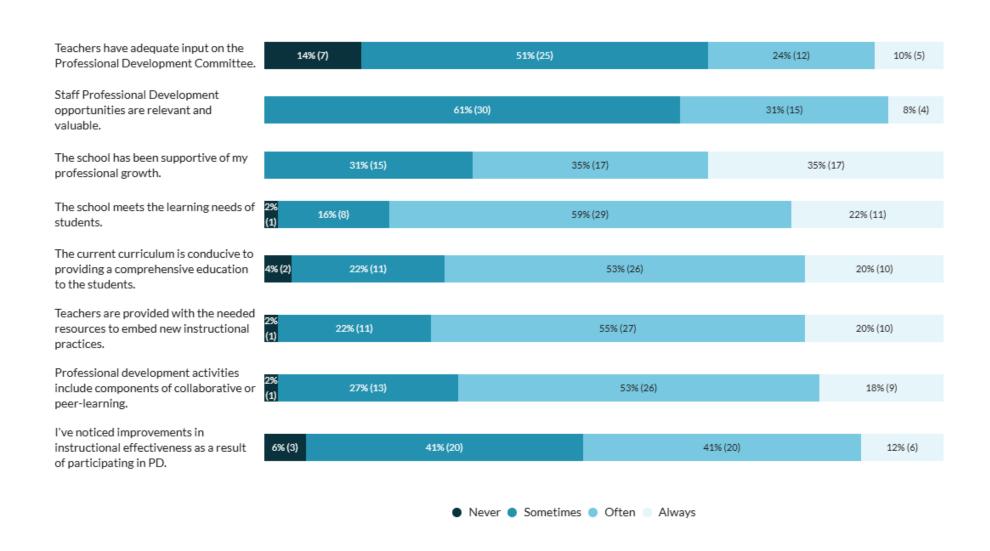

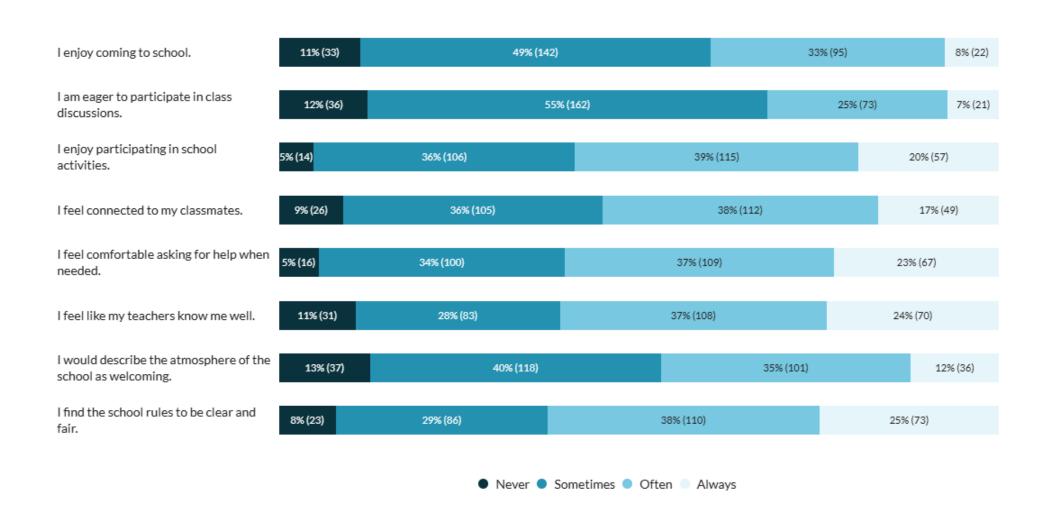

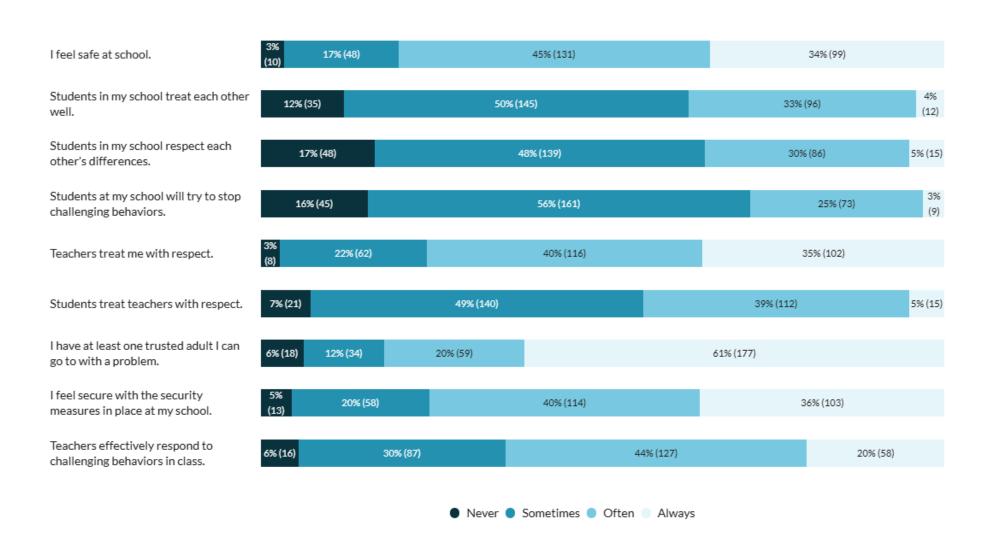

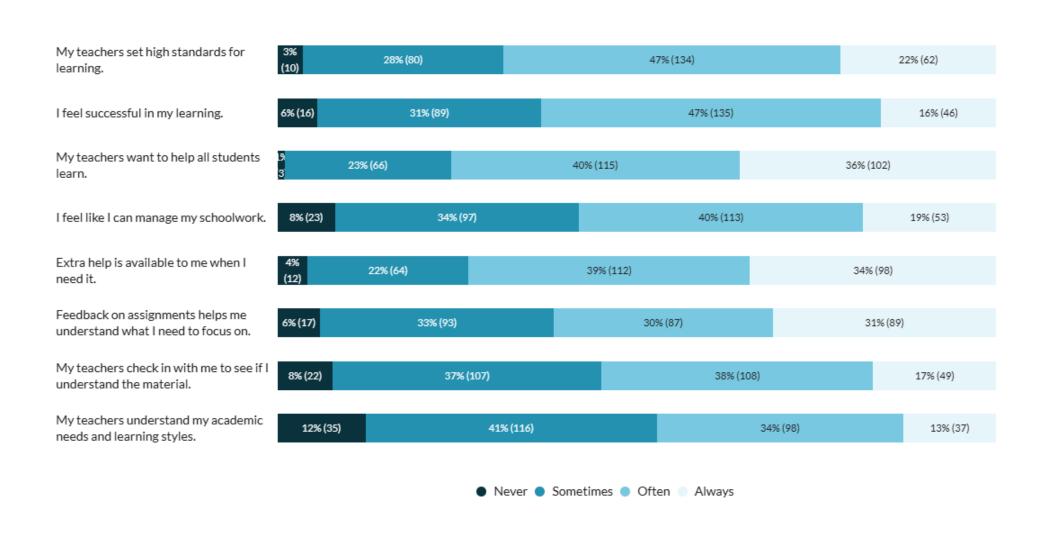
### Q9-17 Perception of Personal and School Safety

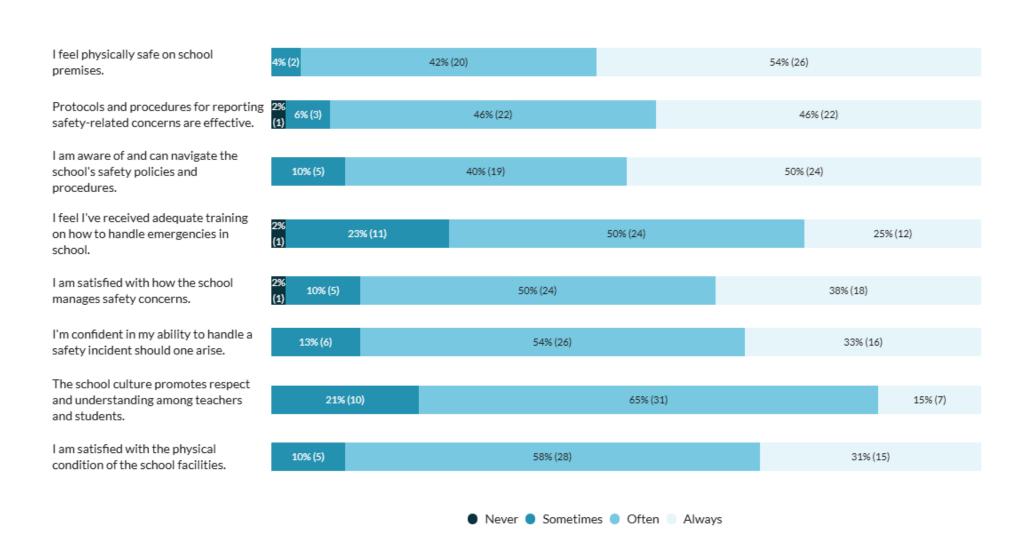

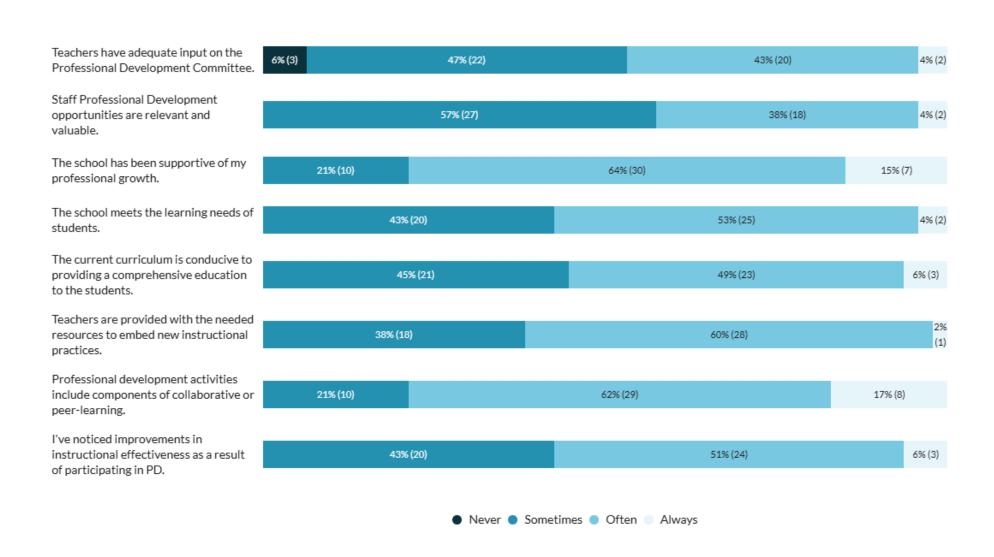
