

## SACRED HEART NEWS



### Behold the Lamb Quick Weekly Lessons on the Sacred Liturgy

#### Fasting

As Catholics, we also fast (abstain from food and drink—except water and necessary medicine) one hour before Mass, or more specifically, one hour before receiving Jesus in the Eucharist. Fasting has multiple purposes throughout salvation history. We see King David fast in repentance and in petition to save his son. We see Queen Esther fast before approaching the king in petition for her people. We even see Jesus fast for 40 days in the wilderness, which is our template for Lent, a season of penitential fasting, prayer and almsgiving—a time to grow closer to God in preparation for the Paschal Mystery.

Fasting is a physical and tangible way that we prepare ourselves for whatever is to follow, whether that be petitioning our Lord or feasting with the Bridegroom at the wedding feast of the Lamb. It marks the importance and reverence of what follows and is a message to both us and God of the depth of which this matters to us. It reflects our spiritual hunger. It reminds us of our reliance on God and reminds our hearts of gratitude. Fasting before we receive the Eucharist reminds us that this reception of our blessed Lord into our bodies is the most important thing we will do this week.


### Local Jubilee Pilgrimage - June 28<sup>th</sup>

### ACA 2025 – SACRED HEART PARISH REBATE PROJECT

This two-story mid-century modern brick building, situated along 14th Street, was constructed in 1955 during the establishment of the church. Initially designed to accommodate parish offices, gathering spaces and living quarters for our priests, it continues to fulfill a vital role today, serving as office space, as well as housing our Youth Ministry Room and Parish Hall.

The flat roof has outlived its intended lifespan and has faced several weather challenges, including damage from a recent windstorm. Taking proactive steps to replace the roof now will help ensure the building remains structurally sound and prevent any potential problems down the line. This investment will protect the building's integrity for years to come. Any gifts received over our ACA goal of \$197,500 will be returned to the parish to help fund replacement of the roof.


