We ask you to devote at least 8 hours to community service. You will create a plan (below) for how you can serve during your journey toward receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. This is an honor system project and signatures documenting time are not required. You may use hours recorded for other purposes, like school requirements.

Service should help those in clear and present need. Though service to family members is of paramount importance, this project is focused on people outside your family circle. The goal is to imitate Christ by doing one or more of the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy.

Complete your Service reflection questions during or shortly after your experience. You will share these reflections during classes and your Confirmation interview.
