TUSD Announces Director and Assistant Principals

(TRACY, CA) – Tracy Unified School District has named the following administraors in the following roles: Eloy Vento as Director of Facilities, Audra Munoz as Assistant Principal at West High School, Ellen Dominguez as Assistant Principal at Bohn Elementary School, and Tyler Mullen as Assistant Principal at Central Elementary School.

Eloy Vento comes to Tracy Unified from Tennessee, where he was owner of a construction and consulting business for the past 10 years. He also has years of experience as the Vice President of Energy Engineering where he led the implementation and oversight of comprehensive energy programs across public education municipalities through the United States, as well as a CTE (Career Technical Education) Architectural and Construction high school teacher. Prior to leaving for Tennessee he was the Director of Facilities for Lincoln Unified School District. Vento received a Bachelor of Science and teaching credential from the University of Tennessee Chattanooga (UTC). He also holds a teaching credential in California along with project management and building operator certifications from Stanislaus State.

During her time at North she has provided instructional support and professional development in social-emotional learning and classroom management, and lead parent-teacher and student-teacher conferences to build community trust and support. Munoz holds a Bachelor's in Human Development from California State University, East Bay, a Master's in Counseling Psychology from the University of San Francisco, and is currently enrolled in the Administrative Credential Program from University of California, Irvine..

Ellen Dominguez has several years of teaching experience and is currently a 5th grade teacher at Wanda Hirsch Elementary School. Dominguez has been a part of the ILT (Instructional Leadership Team) at Hirsch, an Induction Mentor and Peer Coach, on the Curriculum Revisition Team and an EdTSA. She has a Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies and a Master's in Curriculum and Instruction, both from the University of Phoenix. She is currently enrolled in the Administrative Credential Program at CSU Stanislaus.

Tyler Mullen has been an English teacher at Kimball High School since 2010.
