The Board of Education conducted many study sessions and board meetings leading to prioritizing specific projects.



Defined During Study Sessions in November 27, 2017

What does research say about the benefits of Neighborhood Schools?

- o Fosters friendships and keeps communities together in and out of the classroom
- Serves to support a sense of community
- o Promotes students' engagement in activities that occur before and after school
- Promotes greater parent involvement in school activities and increases parent/teacher interaction
- School quality is determined, at least in part, by the distribution of student ability, with higher-ability students improving school quality for all through a peer-group effect

NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOL STUDY

Defined During Study Sessions in November 27, 2017

A new poll by the American Federation of Teachers found:

- 70% of parents said they would prefer a good quality neighborhood school for their children over the ability to have more choice
- o When asked how to improve education 80% of parents said efforts should be focused on ensuring every child has access to a good neighborhood school
