Recruitment & Appointment Process

June 9, 2022

"Members of the Committee shall be appointed by the Board of Education through the following process:

- (a) the District will advertise in the local newspaper, on its website, and in other customary forums, as well as solicit appropriate local groups for applications;
- (b) the Superintendent will review the applications; and

(c) the Superintendent will make recommendations to the Board."





"The Committee shall consist of at least seven (7) members appointed by the Board (*RUSD* appointed 13) from a list of candidates submitting <u>written applications</u>, and based on <u>criteria</u> established by Prop 39, to wit:

- One (1) member shall be the parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the District.
- One (1) member shall be both a parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the District and active in a parent-teacher organization, such as the <u>P.T.A. or a school site council</u>.
- One (1) member active in a <u>business organization</u> representing the business community located in the District.
- One (1) member active in a senior citizens' organization.
- One (1) member active in a bona-fide taxpayers association.
- Two (2) members of the community at-large."

- "To be a qualified person, he or she must be at least <u>18 years of age</u>."
- "The Committee may <u>not include</u> any <u>employee, official of the District or any</u> <u>vendor, contractor or consultant</u> of the District."


