APPOINTMENT PROCESS

“Members of the Committee shall be appointed by the Board of Education through the following process:

- (a) the District will advertise in the local newspaper, on its website, and in other customary forums, as well as solicit appropriate local groups for applications;
- (b) the Superintendent will review the applications; and
- (c) the Superintendent will make recommendations to the Board.”

(Bylaws)

MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

“The Committee shall consist of at least seven (7) members appointed by the Board (*RUSD appointed 13*) from a list of candidates submitting written applications, and based on criteria established by Prop 39, to wit:

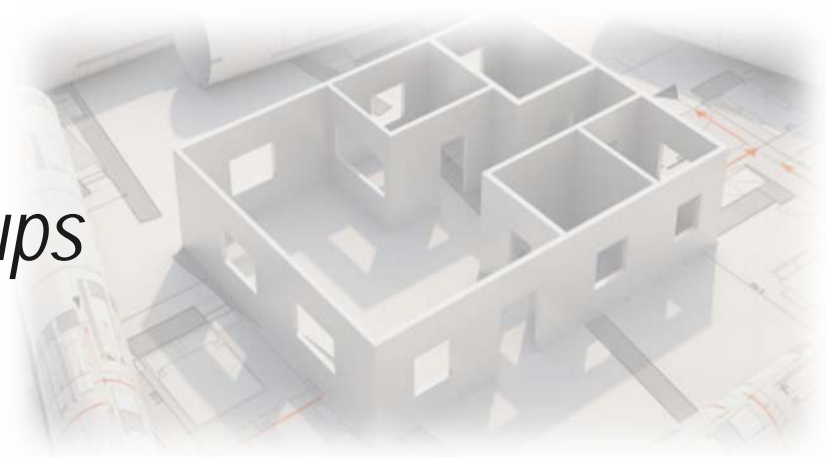
- One (1) member shall be the parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the District.
- One (1) member shall be both a parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the District and active in a parent-teacher organization, such as the P.T.A. or a school site council.
- One (1) member active in a business organization representing the business community located in the District.
- One (1) member active in a senior citizens' organization.
- One (1) member active in a bona-fide taxpayers association.
- Two (2) members of the community at-large.”

(Bylaws)

QUALIFICATION STANDARDS

- "To be a qualified person, he or she must be at least 18 years of age."
- "The Committee may not include any employee, official of the District or any vendor, contractor or consultant of the District."

- Meets criteria established by Proposition 39
- Written application submitted
- Diverse geographic representation
- Commitment to serve the necessary time and term requirements
- No conflict of interests
- Comply with the ethics code included in the Bylaws
- Agree with the Bylaws
