## RESOLUTION NO. 2022/23-28

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE RIVERSIDE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT APPROVING AMENDED AND RESTATED BYLAWS FOR THE RIVERSIDE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT INDEPENDENT CITIZENS' BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Riverside Unified School District (the "District") previously adopted a resolution requesting Riverside County, California (the "Counties") to call an election for general obligation bonds (the "Bond Election") to be held on November 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, notice of the Bond Election was duly given; and on November 8, 2016 the Bond Election was duly held and conducted for the purpose of voting on a measure for the issuance of bonds of the District in the amount of \$392,000,000 ("Measure O"); and

WHEREAS, based on the Canvass and Statement of Results for the Counties, more than fifty-five percent of the votes cast on Measure O were in favor of issuing the aforementioned bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the District previously has established an independent citizens' bond oversight committee (the "Committee") in connection with issuance of bonds under Measure O; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has previously approved Bylaws governing such Committee but now desires to amend and restate such Bylaws, in whole, to make them applicable to Measure O.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF EDUCTION OF THE RIVERSIDE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT DOES HEREBY FIND, DETERMINE AND CERTIFY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Authorization</u>. Measure O was authorized pursuant to paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Section 1 of Article XIIIA of the California Constitution and subdivision (b) of Section 18 of Article XVI of the California Constitution in accordance with the requirements of the Strict Accountability In Local School Construction Bonds Act of 2000 (the "Act").

Section 2. <u>Bylaws</u>. The Committee shall operate pursuant to the Board approved Amended and Restated Bylaws. The Committee shall have only those responsibilities granted to them in the Act, in the resolutions calling for the election for Measure O and in the Amended and Restated Bylaws. The Amended and Restated Bylaws, as submitted herewith and attached hereto, are hereby approved. The previous Bylaws related to Measure O are rescinded and of no further force and effect.
