Dear Parents,

The 2024-2025 school year has flown by so very quickly! It is amazing that summer break is already here! As I am sure you know, it has been another outstanding year at Rather Elementary School! Thanks so much for sharing your children with us! The opportunity to work with them has been very enjoyable and rewarding – they are truly a blessing!

I would like to thank all of the parents who volunteered their time and efforts this school year to help make a positive difference in the education of their children. Many thanks to the parents who volunteered at different school functions and parents who helped their children by monitoring and helping with homework and assignment completion. We want you to know that you are greatly appreciated and that your support helps us to more effectively and efficiently do our job.

Our students continue to excel academically! While we don't have any final state testing data that can be released (third, fourth, and fifth grade students just recently completed the Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress), our end of the year NWEA Testing data shows that our students are making excellent progress! 51.06% of our K – 5th grade students met or exceeded their projected RIT growth score on the NWEA Reading Test while 61.97% of the students met or exceeded their projected RIT growth score on the NWEA Math Test! assessments, we were told that very good things were happening in buildings where at least 50% of the students achieved their projected RIT growth and that in schools where at least 60% of the students achieved their projected RIT growth score, excellent work was being done! In addition, on the final round of Acadience testing, 64.21% percent of our students finished in the at or above grade level categories. This is great progress considering that we started the school year with just 56.90% of our students at or above grade level! We are so proud of our students' hard work and the growth that they have shown and we are extremely thankful for the incredible, dedicated, hard-working staff that we have at Rather!

Rather students were also hard at work being the best RAMS (respecting others, accepting responsibility, making safe choices, showing kindness) they could be each day. During the 2024-2025 school year, Rather students collectively received 77,930 RAMS rewards! That is an average of 254.67 RAMS rewards per student for the school year!!!

On behalf of the staff at Rather Elementary School, I would like to take this opportunity to wish all of you a safe, fun-filled, enjoyable, productive summer vacation! We hope that all of you return in the fall but if you do move over the summer, either within the district or out of district, please call Ionia Public Schools Central Office at 616-527-9280 and let them know.
