III. Proposed Levy Rates for the School Year 2022-2023

In accordance with the provisions of WV Code 11-8-12, proposed Levy Rates for the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 are being presented for approval and authorization by the Board in order to submit them to the State Board of Education and the State Tax Commissioner for their approvals. Levy rates for 2022-2023 are as follows:

Regular Levy – As determined by the Legislature per WV Code 11-8-6f.

Special Levy – As per renewal of November 6, 2018, effective the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, July 1, 2020, July 1, 2021, July 1, 2022, and July 1, 2023.
