# VII. Departmental Updates

a. Maintenance Report – William Hensley – Attachment U1

Mr. Hensley addressed the Board and reported things were doing good. They do need to take care of some work orders. He reported on drains at Williamson Pre K-8 playground and Tug Valley High School press box.

### 495 b. Treasurer's Report – Beth Daniels – Attachment U2

Mrs. Daniels gave the report. We had received about 98 ½ % of the estimated local revenue budgeted and have spent about 85% of our total budget. Mr. Tomblin, our workers compensation agent, marketed our account and recommended we go with Brickstreet/Encovia. Our e-mod had dropped to 9.3%. The 22 surplus buses had been advertised in the newspaper. The hope was to receive bids on them and remove them from the storage area. About \$95,000.00 had been spent replacing items lost due to the recent flooding of the Tug Valley High School football stadium.

Mr. McCoy reported on the baseball fields at Mingo Central High School. He had a handout of pictures that had been made there. There had been a couple of issues that caused setbacks but the work should be completed by June 4, 2021. Lighting at Tug Valley fields should be started around June 15, 2021.

Mingo Central sent an update on the sodding of the baseball field. Due to the weather, larger jobs and waiting for the lighting to be finished, the field will not be finished in time to play a game on it this year.

### VIII. General Considerations

# a. Discussion and possible action to develop Administrative Guidelines to create a process for including summer school recovery grades toward athletic eligibility. - Dr. Johnny Branch

The hope was to develop new guidelines for athletic eligibility. If a student recovers a grade, all grades would be averaged to determine eligibility. There would be stringent guidelines in order to be able to recover a grade. Example – all work would be done at school, there would not be any work accepted from home, etc.

Mr. Preece made the motion to develop Administrative Guidelines to create a process for including summer school recovery grades toward athletic eligibility. Ms. McCormick seconded that motion. The motion carried with a vote of 4/0.

### b. Discussion and possible action in adoption of ELA textbooks - Dr. Johnny Branch

Dr. Branch reported the vendors that had been selected for the English Language Arts adoption; these were selected with teacher input and would cost approximately \$600,000.00. Selected was Benchmark Education for grades K-5, Amplify for grades 6-8 and McGraw Hill for grades 9-12. The adoption is for six years.

Ms. McCormick made a motion to adopt ELA textbooks. Mr. Slone seconded that motion. The motion carried with a vote of 4/0.

# c. Discussion and possible action on approval of 2021-2022 budget – Beth Daniels and Rod McCoy

Mr. Preece made the motion to approve the budget as prepared by Mrs. Daniels and Mr. McCoy for years 2021-2022. Mr. Slone seconded that motion. The motion carried with a vote of 4/0.

# d. Discussion and possible action in approving school-based fundraising groups for 2021-2022-Beth Daniels and Rod McCoy

Mr. McCoy had a handout and made the presentation. There was questions and answers.

Mr. Slone made the motion to approve the school-based fundraising groups for 2021-2022. Mr. Preece seconded that motion. The motion carried with a vote of 4/0.

#### e. Discussion of Board Goals for 2021-2022 school year.

Mr. Preece led the discussion. He had several ideas to bring forth as goals for the Board to achieve.

His list included establishing vocational classes for grades 7-12 beginning in September; Math and Reading scores to be at or above state level OR above the 40<sup>th</sup> percentile; stress phonics curriculum in grades 1 and 2, and comprehension in grades 3 and 4; attendance for students and personnel would be 90% or higher; construction of the CTE building at Tug Valley would be completed by August 15, 2022; implement summer school tutoring program for students performing under 40<sup>th</sup> percentile; making use of school facilities more during the summer; limit out-of-county travel for teachers; hold two Board meetings per month, a workshop and a regular; inventory for schools online for items over \$100 in value; monthly workshops to include indepth updates on GOAL progress.
