b. Maintenance Report – William Hensley

Mr. Hensley gave the maintenance report. Items mentioned were restrooms at Gilbert and Williamson, AC units at Lenore, Tug Valley Press box, bleachers at Gilbert and at other schools, the playground at Williamson, the grass cutting contract, and work orders.

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c. Treasurer's Report – Beth Daniels

Mrs. Daniels had a handout – reconciliation of checking account by funds. As of today, we had received about 90% of our budgeted revenue, and had spent about 75% of it. Finance is working on getting this year closed out. The library equipment for Williamson K-8 library had been ordered; it was to be delivered and installed on June 1, 2021. A meeting had been set up with a Latta's representative regarding playground equipment for Dingess.

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Mr. McCoy gave an update on the lighting at the baseball and softball fields at Tug Valley and Mingo Central.

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VII. General Considerations

a. Discussion of new textbook adoption - Dr. Johnny Branch

Dr. Branch addressed the Board regarding the English Language Arts adoption this year. The vendors chosen were Benchmark Advance Grades K-5, Amplify Grade 6-8, McCraw Hill grades 9-12. Our teachers had reviewed materials and attended virtual sessions with all vendors. These are the publishers the teachers chose after reviewing all the material. The costs would be Amplify \$122,000.00, McGraw Hill \$113,000.00, Benchmark Advance \$350,000.00. The total budget would be around \$585,000.00. The adoption would include the hardback texts and the online materials.

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Chargers for the laptops/chrome books would be ordered for the schools. There was discussion regarding inclusion of entrepreneurial curriculum in middle school grades, and modernization for Career and Technical Education classes.

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b. Discussion and possible action regarding placing county audit services out for bid - Beth Daniels

Mrs. Daniels addressed the board regarding this section. Since we are in the third and final year of the audit contract, it is time to put the audit services back out for bid.

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295 Mr. Preece made a motion to put the audit services out for bid, bring the bids back to the board along Mrs. 296 Daniels' expertise, give a recommendation about each one and let the Board make a decision. Mr. Slone 297 seconded that motion. The motion carried with a vote of 5/0.

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Mrs. Daniels explained there is a list of approved vendors from the state. The process is sending out vendor packages and going through each of the ones that showed interest. There would be a committee that included a citizen, a Board member, a couple of Finance people and the Superintendent.

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c. Discussion and possible action in setting sick leave incentive for school year 2021-2022 - Beth Daniels Mrs. Daniels spoke regarding setting an amount for the sick leave incentive. She thought we could go with the amount we have used in the past. We have seen a reduction in substitutes prior to COVID-19. That amount was \$600.00. With everyday missed that amount would be cut.

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Mr. Preece made a motion to approve the \$600 sick leave incentive for the school year 2021-2022. It was seconded by Ms. McCormick. The motion carried with a vote of 5/0.

Mr. Spence addressed the Board. The Vaccine clinic is this Friday; it is for employee children who need the second shot. There will be a workshop on Monday, April 26, 2021.
