The program NetWorth is also known as "Get a Life Program". Students would simulate personal budgeting using a given certain set of criteria. This is to help them make better choices for the future (college or vocational training).

Another program is the 529 College Savings Plan. There is a "When I Grow UP" essay contest. Winners receive monies toward a SMART529 College Savings Account. There is a teacher essay contest for even more cash prizes.

WVABLE is a savings and investment solution for people with disabilities. Money could be saved in this program without losing other benefits such as Medicaid or SSI.
