- Update instructional technology for modern teaching standards in core subjects like reading, science, technology, engineering and math (STEM)
- Update classrooms and labs for career and technical education (CTE) classes
- Continue strategic partnerships with UC Riverside and Riverside City College to strengthen STEM education

Upgrade and Repair Aging Riverside Schools

- Improve student safety and security systems
- In RUSD, 33 of our schools were built more than 40 years ago and five are more than 100 years old
- Repair or replace aging, outdated classrooms and school buildings
- Retrofit older schools to enhance earthquake safety
- Improve access for students with disabilities

Measure O: Local Funding for Local Schools

In order to maintain high-quality education in every one of our local schools, the RUSD Board of Education voted unanimously to place Measure O, a \$392 million bond measure, on the November 8, 2016 ballot. If approved by 55% of Riverside voters, Measure O funding would help repair and improve RUSD schools.



- No funds for administrators' and teachers' salaries or benefits
- Citizens' Oversight and annual, independent audits
- All money will stay in Riverside to support local students
- No money could be taken by the State
- Would cost property owners \$59 per \$100,000 of assessed (not market) value annually
- Every school would benefit from bond funds
