| Progress monitoring through Aimsweb | Grades K-8 | Reading and Math | Determines how students are progressing toward grade-level goals within the intervention. | Administered by RTI teacher - paper/pencil and online | Given approximately every 2 weeks for students receiving Tiers 2 or 3 interventions | Results are shared with teachers and parents every 4.5 weeks. |
