STUDENT AWARDS

THE WILLIAM S. THOMAS SCHOLARSHIP PRIZE is comprised of several awards. William S. Thomas, an eminent attorney of Baltimore City who died in 1947, donated a substantial sum to the School in memory of his close relative, Maggie V. Hugg. He specified that prizes be given to leading scholars in the School in tribute to members of his family and Dr. I. Ridgeway Trimble, Jr. Accordingly, part of the income from the money left to the School is used for prizes as determined by the Board of Trustees. These prizes are given as follows:

THE ANITA RENSHAW PRESTMAN PRIZE, for the leading scholar of grade 6

THE MARGARET V. HUGG PRIZE, for the leading scholar of grade 7

THE ZAIDEE T. THOMAS PRIZE, for the leading scholar of grade 8

THE JACOB B. HUGG PRIZE, for the leading scholar of the third form

THE JOHN L. THOMAS PRIZE, for the leading scholar of the fourth form

THE I. RIDGEWAY TRIMBLE, JR. PRIZE, for the leading scholar of the fifth form

THE MARION HUGG PRIZE, for the leading scholar of the sixth form

THE WILLIAM S. THOMAS PRIZE, for the valedictorian

THE WILLIAM CABELL BRUCE, JR. ATHLETIC PRIZE is awarded annually to the student in one of the four upper forms most conspicuous for general proficiency in athletic sports and exercises over a two-year period, and this while conducting himself appropriately in areas of general citizenship. The prize, presented by Mrs. William Cabell Bruce in memory of her son, who died in 1910, was first given in 1911 and is one of the oldest awards in the School. The cup's inscription says, in part, "Given in memory of William Cabell Bruce, Junior, who died while a pupil in the School, after five years of active and honorable participation in its athletic sports and exercises."

THE EDWARD FENIMORE AWARD was established in 1963 by Edward R. Fenimore in loving tribute to the memory of his son, Edward R. Fenimore, Jr. '59, whose extraordinary courage, determination, perseverance, and accomplishment inspired all who knew him. This award is presented to the senior who has best exemplified these characteristics while a student at Gilman.

THE REDMOND C. S. FINNEY AWARD is presented to the Upper School student who has distinguished himself, through action and example, by encouraging harmony through his dedication to and practice of those human values necessary to eliminate racism, prejudice, and intolerance. The award was established in 1992.

THE PETER PARROTT BLANCHARD AWARD is presented to the student who, by his cheerful helpfulness, in many ways has greatly contributed to the successful and pleasant life in the School. The award is made possible by a fund donated by the children and relatives of Peter P. Blanchard, who was business manager of the School from 1917 to 1944. The qualities of this award were outstanding in the life of Mr. Blanchard, in whose memory the prize is given.

THE DANIEL BAKER, JR. MEMORIAL AWARD is presented in memory of Daniel Baker, Jr. to a member of the graduating class who, through thoughtfulness and by reason of his character, has contributed to the general welfare of his fellow men. The prize was given by Mr. Baker's stepson, Dr. Mason Faulconer Lord, until his death in 1965, and is continued by the family. It was established in 1952.

THE WILLIAM A. FISHER MEDALLION is presented to a member of the junior or senior class who has been at Gilman for three consecutive years and has exemplified the highest level of scholarship, leadership, and character. The medallion was established in 1903 by the late Mrs. William Cabell Bruce in honor of her father, Judge William A. Fisher, the first president of the Board of Trustees.

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT FUNDS

Each academic year, the following funds allow teachers to grow professionally as well as explore topics that will ultimately enhance students' classroom experience. The School gratefully recognizes those individuals, families, and organizations who recognize the importance of faculty development and support these funds.

THE APGAR AWARD FOR TEACHING EXCELLENCE, established by Mr. and Mrs. Mahlon Apgar PP, recognizes, honors, and rewards individual teachers who have had demonstrable impact on their students in terms of: (1) their ability to motivate students' interest, curiosity, and love of learning in their subject; (2) their willingness to propose and apply new teaching concepts and methods that expand students' horizons and potential; and (3) their skill in serving as mentors to stimulate students' intellectual development beyond the confines of their curriculum and official responsibilities.

BAETJER FACULTY FUND provides grants for continuing education. Memorial gifts from the Baetjer family and friends and a legacy from the estate created this endowed fund.

THE BROADUS-HUBBARD AWARD sponsors professional development or travel for faculty. It was established through a gift from Mr. and Mrs. Thomas H. Broadus, Jr. PP and Mr. and Mrs. A. C. Hubbard, Jr. PP. The endowment enables Gilman to present an award each year to a member of the Gilman faculty or administration. The recipient is selected by the Head of School after consultation with the Board of Trustees.

CLASS OF 1947 FUND FOR MERITORIOUS TEACHING was established in 1986 to encourage excellence in teaching. Recipients of the award are selected based upon excellence in teaching and inspirational influence upon students. Each year's recipient(s) of the award are selected strictly on the basis of merit, with prior selection not diminishing a teacher's opportunity for re-selection.

CLASS OF 1955 HENRY CALLARD PENN TEACHING FELLOW, created in honor of the Class of 1955's 50th reunion, supports teacher candidates in an intelligent and thoughtful internship that captures the model for teaching at Gilman School.

CLASS OF 1957 FACULTY SUMMER SABBATICALS AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT FUND provides support for a faculty member to travel, take classes, or attend conferences that are relevant to his or her area of study. The Class of 1957 established the fund in honor of its 50th reunion as a part of the Character · Leadership · Commitment campaign.

CLASS OF 1978 COMMUNITY & DIVERSITY FUND supports programs, initiatives, and educational opportunities for teachers to build community and celebrate diversity, equity, and inclusion at Gilman.

CLASS OF 1979 TEACHER/COACH/ADVISOR AWARD is awarded to three teachers, one from each division, who best exemplify the qualities of a Gilman teacher, coach, and advisor.

THE MICHAEL HOWARD COOPER PENN TEACHING FELLOW supports teacher candidates who serve for one year. Established by the Cooper family in 1981 as a memorial to Michael, a member of the Gilman class of 1985, Cooper Penn Teaching Fellows are new to teaching, excel in both character and potential, and combine a concern for academic excellence with an appreciation of those personal and spiritual qualities that lead students to a mature respect for themselves and for all persons.

THE JOHN K. AND ROBERT F. M. CULVER TEACHING CHAIR FOR THE HUMANITIES AND/OR THE PERFORMING ARTS is an endowed faculty chair established by Rosalie Calvert and Donald M. Culver '43 in memory of his brothers John K. Culver, Jr. '34 and Robert F. M. Culver '37, both of whom met untimely deaths. John Culver perished in a tragic auto accident on January 11, 1942, and Captain Robert F. M. Culver, USMCR died as a result of wounds sustained on Saipan in World War II. By ensuring their legacy at Gilman School, Donald M. Culver honors their memories and shares in his brothers' love of Gilman.

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT FUNDS

OWEN AND CLINTON DALY FACULTY DEVELOPMENT FUND gives members of the Gilman faculty and administration the opportunity to broaden their professional growth through travel or continuing education. Father and son Owen Daly II '43 and Clinton R. Daly '74 established the fund.

THE EDWARD K. DUNN FACULTY FUND was established by the family of Edward K. Dunn, a graduate of the Class of 1918, a member of the Board of Trustees for 54 years, and a loyal and devoted alumnus of Gilman, who was the first alumnus to serve as president of the Board. The Head of School annually awards the income from this fund to those members of the Gilman faculty who have made an exceptional contribution to the development of the character of students.

DAWSON L. FARBER, JR. AWARD is presented to the faculty member who is considered to have been most helpful to his fellow teachers. Established in 1988 by John Armiger '62, the award honors Dawson L. Farber, Jr. '35, who served as a member of the Board of Trustees from 1964 until his death in 2007. He was named a lifetime trustee in 1981. The recipient is selected by the Head of School and heads of the respective school divisions after consultation with the Board of Trustees.

CHARLES C. FENWICK, JR. '66 DISTINGUISHED TEACHER/COACH CHAIR recognizes an exceptional teacher in the classroom and on the fields. Established in 2019 by Benjamin H. Griswold IV '58, Michael Hankin PP, Charles E. Noell III, and R. Davis Noell '97, this award honors Charles C. Fenwick, Jr. '66, Lifetime Trustee, for his years of service and support to Gilman.

THE REDMOND C.S. FINNEY CHAIR IN AMERICAN HISTORY recognizes an individual who embodies Gilman values and demonstrates steadfast dedication to the study of U.S. History, with an emphasis on the Constitution.

THE JOHNNIE L. FOREMAN, JR. FACULTY FELLOWSHIP introduces aspiring teachers to careers in education by giving a recent college graduate the opportunity to explore the profession of teaching at Gilman School. The fellowship honors retired Director of Community, Inclusion and Equity Johnnie L. Foreman, Jr., who taught, coached, mentored, and advised generations of Gilman men. Mr. Thomas H. Broadus III '86, PP and Mrs. Anne Eggleston Broadus PP established the fellowship in 2015.

GILMAN ADVISOR FUND AND AWARD was established in September 1998 by Mr. Stephen T. Scott '64 and Mrs. Elizabeth F. Scott. The fund provides grants to Lower, Middle, and Upper School faculty members to attend summer programs, courses, or workshops in the area of counseling and advising. In addition, an award in the form of a stipend is given to the Lower, Middle, and Upper School faculty member who has excelled in this area.

THE ROBERT F. GREENHILL '54 AND GAYLE G. GREENHILL-RUTH W. WILLIAMS DISTINGUISHED TEACHING CHAIR FOR MATHEMATICS is an endowed faculty chair honoring the life and influence of one of Gilman's most inspiring teachers, role models, outstanding educators, and trailblazers, Ruth Weaver Williams. Established by Robert F. Greenhill '54 and his late wife, Gayle Greenhill, in 2018, the chair honors an experienced faculty member in the Math Department who emulates the same qualities as the chair's namesake: teaching acumen, scholarship, and deep dedication to students both in and out of the classroom.

THE HEAD OF SCHOOL'S INNOVATION ENDOWMENT FUND, established by Waldo "Bo" Newcomer '48 and Curran "Cub" Harvey '47, honors all innovators and, in particular, three great Head of Schools of the period from 1943 to 1993, Henry Callard, Ludlow Baldwin, and Redmond C. S. Finney. This fund provides the Head of School with funds to nurture innovation, new ideas, and concepts at Gilman.

TOM HEALY FACULTY PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT FUND, gives members of the Lower and Middle School faculty the opportunity to broaden their professional growth through continuing education. The fund was established by Thomas J. Healey '60.

HESS FACULTY FUND is available to teachers who have been at Gilman for a minimum of ten years, and creatively recognizes superior teaching.

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT FUNDS

THE MICHAEL ROSS HIMELFARB '94 PERFORMING ARTS FUND was established by Margaret and Dick Himelfarb, the parents of alumnus and past faculty member Michael R. Himelfarb '94, to provide financial support for the advancement and support of performing arts programs and faculty at Gilman School.

THE WILMA MASON AND C. HUNTLEY HILLIARD FACULTY CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT FUND was established in 1992 in memory of Wilma Mason and C. Huntley Hilliard. This fund enables Lower School faculty members to enrich and enhance portions of the Lower School curriculum on a regular basis. Each year, a faculty member, or a group of faculty, is/are selected for this summer research and development grant. Wilma Hilliard was a devoted member of the Gilman Lower School faculty for 20 years. C. Huntley Hilliard was a member of the Gilman faculty for more than 30 years, taught mathematics in the Lower School, and served as chairman of the industrial arts department.

THE TIMOTHY HOLLEY, JR. '77 ATHLETIC DIRECTORSHIP supports the Athletics Department through an endowed fund. Mr. Jonathon S. Jacobson '79 and Mrs. Joanna Jacobson gifted the directorship in honor of a respected and valued member of the Gilman community, Timothy Holley, Jr., Class of 1977, one of Gilman's most extraordinary student-athletes and long-serving athletic director. Among Tim Holley's many accomplishments: 1977 William Cabell Bruce Prize recipient; senior football, basketball, and baseball team captain; varsity basketball coach from 1987-1994; and athletic director from 1997-2018.

THE JANET FAMILY LECTURESHIP FUND provides monies for an honorarium, travel costs, printing of program materials, and other expenses incurred in bringing a distinguished person to campus to present a program for faculty and students in a particular discipline or relative to a particular issue. Rina L. and Howard A. Janet PP established the fund.

THE KITCHEL FAMILY TEACHER/COACH/ADVISOR AWARD was established during Gilman's *First Things First* campaign by Mr. D. Brooks Kitchel II '88 and Mrs. Denise Kitchel in order to annually recognize an outstanding Gilman educator. Selected at the Head of School's discretion, the award recipient will be a distinguished teacher/coach/advisor whose educational excellence, both in the classroom and beyond, is worthy of special appreciation.

LINEHAN FAMILY STUDY AND TRAVEL FUND is an endowed fund to sponsor professional development or travel. The fund was established through a gift from Mr. and Mrs. Earl Linehan PP. It enables Gilman to provide grants to Lower, Middle, and Upper School faculty members each year.

WALTER LORD MIDDLE SCHOOL TEACHING PRIZE recognizes a faculty member who is committed to teaching skills and helping students develop skills of writing effectively, reading with comprehension, speaking with persuasion, and researching analytically, all keystones of a Gilman Middle School education. Jonathan M. Hornblower, a friend and attorney of Walter Lord '35, established this prize in January 2003.

WALTER LORD SABBATICAL, established by a bequest from Walter Lord '35, provides funds to further faculty education and offer sabbaticals on an annual basis.

ALLEN F. MAULSBY TEACHER/COACH ENDOWMENT FUND IN MEMORY OF TYLER CAMPBELL, established with a bequest from the estate of Allen F. Maulsby '40, is used annually for the development of teaching and coaching skills through attendance at professional workshops, courses, and seminars, particularly those relating to the sports of lacrosse, hockey, and football.

ALLEN F. MAULSBY TEACHER/COACH ENDOWMENT FUND IN MEMORY OF EDWARD RUSSELL, established with a bequest from the estate of Allen F. Maulsby '40, is used annually for the development of teaching and coaching skills through attendance at professional workshops, courses, and seminars, particularly those relating to the sports of wrestling and football.

THE OBER FAMILY FACULTY GRANT FOR ENGLISH STUDIES provides a grant for a member of the faculty in the English Department to study abroad each summer. The Ober Family established this endowed fund in 1997.

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT FUNDS

THE PASSANO HEAD OF SCHOOL'S FUND was established in 2002 by Mr. & Mrs. William M. Passano, Jr. '48. The fund was established for capital purposes and special projects. It is to be used at the discretion of the Head of School.

PATERNOTTE TRAVEL AND STUDY FUNDS provide grants to all faculty members to travel and to attend summer programs, courses, or workshops in the areas of humanities (history, languages, and English) and the STEM subjects (science, technology, engineering, and math), in the United States and abroad. Mr. and Mrs. William L. Paternotte '63, PP and their children established the fund for the humanities in 1999 and the fund for the sciences and math in 2015.

THE WILLIAM H. PORTER FUND FOR SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, AND MATHEMATICS gives faculty the means to discover innovative ways to teach those disciplines, commonly referred to as STEM, by encouraging integrated, experiential learning. The fund encourages innovative, well-reasoned proposals designed to change the teaching of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. Geraldine Dell and Samuel Dell III '61 established the Porter Fund, named for the highly regarded retired physics teacher William H. Porter, to mark Sam's 50th reunion in 2011.

THE P. MEREDITH REESE MEMORIAL FUND was established by the Board of Trustees endowment fund in memory of Meredith Reese, who so ably served Gilman School for 29 years as teacher, coach, advisor, and director of studies. Memorial gifts from his friends and a legacy from his estate created an endowment fund to support summer learning sabbaticals for faculty.

THE RIEPE FAMILY SABBATICAL rewards consistent excellence in teaching and promotes the continuing educational development of the faculty. A member of the faculty from the Lower, Middle, or Upper School each year will be awarded a semester sabbatical. To be eligible, a faculty member must have been at Gilman for at least seven years and have achieved full teacher status. Mr. and Mrs. James S. Riepe PP generously established this endowed fund in 1999.

THE ROHDE FAMILY MATH ENDOWMENT will be awarded as a stipend annually to one or multiple members of Gilman's Upper School Math Department for their additional work in re-evaluating and rewriting curriculum to marry traditional math principles with innovative ideas as part of an overall effort to advance the Math Department at Gilman. Awards will be made at the discretion of the Upper School Math Department Chair in consultation with the Head of Upper School.

THE BRENT A. ROSENBERG '05 FUND FOR TEACHING AND LEARNING provides faculty and staff with the resources, education, and training needed to identify and work with different styles of learning. Proceeds from the fund may be used to support professional development and educational opportunities for faculty and staff, including consultations with experts on campus and at workshops and professional conferences. The fund was established in 2011 by Brent's parents, Mr. Frank B. Rosenberg '76 and Mrs. Ann Rosenberg, and was supported by many gifts from family and friends.

THE EDWARD T. RUSSELL CHAIR is Gilman's first endowed faculty chair. Established in 1979 in memory of Edward T. Russell, who served on the Gilman faculty from 1915 until 1963. This fund was created by alumni, friends, and relatives of Mr. Russell and Mrs. Florence Campbell Russell, who shared her husband's love of Gilman. The recipient is selected by the Head of School after consultation with the Board of Trustees.

SCHAPIRO SUMMER STUDY GRANT offers grants for a faculty member to attend a continuing education workshop in the United States. Mr. and Mrs. Benjamin Schapiro PP created this fund.

THE SCHWEIZER FAMILY DRUG AND ALCOHOL FUND was established in 1999 by Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Schweizer, Jr. '62. This fund supports Gilman School drug and alcohol education and counseling programs.

THE J. RICHARD AND MARY MCC. THOMAS DEVELOPMENT CHAIR was established in 2015 by Mr. J. Richard Thomas, Sr. '43 and Mrs. Mary McC. Thomas to support an exemplary Gilman faculty or staff member. The recipient will be an individual who embodies Gilman values and demonstrates steadfast dedication to the School's outreach and development efforts.

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT FUNDS

THE WIELER FAMILY DISTINGUISHED TEACHING CHAIR FOR CLASSICS supports the Classics Department through an endowed fund. In 2017, dedicated and steadfast volunteers Board of Trustees President Mr. Scott A. Wieler, his wife, Mrs. Mary Baily Wieler, and son, Mr. James B. Wieler '09, generously established this endowed fund in honor of James Wieler's lasting regard for classics department instructor Thomas "Toby" Broadus III '86, a favorite Latin teacher. Income from The Wieler Family Distinguished Teaching Chair for Classics will be used to support the salary of the designated recipient, who will hold the chair until his or her successor is named.

FREDERICK R. WILLIAMS SCIENCE FACULTY DEVELOPMENT FUND was established in 2002 with a gift from the estate of Frederick Williams, who taught at Gilman for four decades. The purpose of this fund is to provide opportunities for teachers (preferably younger teachers) in the Science Department to gain a wider understanding of their field and greater enthusiasm for teaching science.

CARY WOODWARD EXCHANGE PROGRAM AND YOUNG FACULTY DEVELOPMENT FUND promotes and supports exchange between Gilman and other countries. The fund provides grants to Lower, Middle, and Upper School young faculty members to travel and attend summer programs, courses, or workshops in the United States and abroad. Faculty members must have been at Gilman for at least three years and no more than five years and have achieved full teacher status. Friends and family of Cary Woodward '53 established this fund in honor of his retirement from Gilman after 35 years.

FRANK C. WRIGHT, JR. FACULTY DEVELOPMENT FUND was established in 1998 as a gift from the estate of Frank C. Wright, Jr. Funds are to be used at the discretion of the Head of School to support faculty research and continuing education.
