### **CLASS TITLE: Heavy Equipment & Refuse Operator (Range 25)**

#### **BASIC FUNCTION:**

Under direction of the assigned supervisor, operate skid-steer, tractors, trash trucks, roll-off trucks, mowers and various grounds vehicles and equipment moving hauling and transporting dirt, trash, recycled and other grounds materials, equipment and debris.

Assist in the installation and repair of concrete, asphalt, fencing and playground equipment and other grounds duties.

#### **REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:**

Operate skid-steer and tractors with attachments at a skilled level picking up rocks, sand, dirt and grounds debris. *E*

Grading, trenching, backfilling, compacting loading, hauling and digging. *E*

Operate trash truck and roll-off truck at a skilled level picking up refuse & debris off-loading & transporting. *E*

Picking up and delivering large roll-off containers. *E*

Operate grounds mowers related equipment at a skilled level. *E*

Prepare, install, repair and replace concrete, asphalt, fencing and playground equipment. *E*

Perform routine maintenance on grounds equipment. *E*

Basic record keeping. *E*

Perform other related duties as assigned.

#### **KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES:**

##### Knowledge of:

Proper operation of heavy equipment.

Perform daily vehicle inspections per CHP, D.O.T. and other applicable agencies.

Technical aspects of grading, trenching, turf and field renovations.

Operating and routine maintenance of grounds equipment and vehicles.

Principles, methods, equipment and tools in the work of asphalt, concrete, fencing, playground equipment and general ground maintenance.

Basic record keeping techniques.

Health and safety regulations.

District organization, policies and objectives.

Ability to:

Understand and follow written and oral directions.  
Communicate effectively with others.  
Establish and maintain effective relationships.  
Work independently with minimal supervision.  
Meet schedules and timelines.  
Diagnose and troubles-shoot work related issues.  
Assist drivers moving bins into position for pick-up

**EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:**

Any equivalent to: graduation from high school and 1 year journey-level work operating heavy equipment and concrete, asphalt, fencing and playground maintenance, installation and repairs.

Valid California Drivers License Class A with air brake endorsement.  
Must meet and maintain all DMV and State license requirements

**WORKING CONDITIONS:**

Environment:

Indoor and outdoor environment.  
Driving a vehicle to conduct work.

Physical Abilities:

Lifting carrying pulling and pushing.  
Heavy physical labor.  
Bending at the waist.  
Standing for extended periods of time.  
Dexterity of hands and fingers to operate equipment and vehicles.  
Kneeling and crouching.
