CLASS TITLE: HARDSCAPE TECHNICIAN (Range 25)

BASIC FUNCTION:

Under the direction of an assigned supervisor, perform journeyman level concrete, asphalt, fencing, masonry and playground maintenance, installations and repairs.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS:

The Hardscape Specialist classification is a journeyman level position. Workers will perform journeyman level maintenance repairs and installations at District facilities using a variety of equipment under the direction of an assigned supervisor and in conjunction with the Lead Grounds Maintenance Worker II.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

Prepare, install, repair, replace and finish various sized hardscape surfaces, such as asphalt, concrete and block, and general maintenance projects at a journey-man level. *E*

Prepare, install, repair, replace and/or finish poured in place rubberized surfacing and general maintenance projects. *E*

Prepare, install, repair, replace and/or maintain playground equipment and surfacing. *E*

Prepare, install, repair, replace and/or maintain chain link, ornamental iron and other types of fencing. *E*

Operate and use a variety of light, medium, and heavy duty equipment to include various hand tools and motor driven vehicles to install and maintain District property. *E*

Perform maintenance and repairs of equipment, including playground equipment, basketball hoops and backboards, swings, fences and other equipment as needed. *E*

Perform related duties as assigned.

KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES

KNOWLEDGE OF:

Principles, methods, equipment and tools of journeyman level work in asphalt, concrete, fencing, playground equipment and general grounds maintenance.

Safety procedures pertaining to work place environment.

Basic record keeping.

ABILITY TO:

Understand and follow written and oral directions.
Communicate effectively with others.
Work independently with minimal supervision.
Meet schedules and timelines.
Diagnose and trouble shoot work related issues.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

Any equivalent to: graduation from high school and one (1) year journey-level work in concrete, asphalt, fencing and playground maintenance installation and repairs and able to pass a District administered test for prep and finish work.

LICENSES AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Valid California Driver's License.

Indoor and outdoor environment.
Adverse weather conditions.
Driving a vehicle to conduct work.

PHYSICAL ABILITIES:

Lifting carrying pulling and pushing heavy objects.
Perform heavy physical labor.
Seeing to inspect and clean equipment and perform work.
Bending at the waist.
Standing for extended periods of time.
Dexterity of hands and fingers to operate equipment and vehicles.
Kneeling and crouching.
