Transportation Applications

Dear Parent or Guardian:

The Liberty Union High School District is pleased to inform you that we are now accepting school bus applications and bus pass payments electronically for the 2025-2026 school year.

To apply for a bus pass for your student, simply click the link below and enter your student ID number. If you don't know it, contact your student's school.

AN APPLICATION MUST BE INPUT FOR EACH STUDENT.

We are not accepting in-person applications. All Applications must be done online using the link below.

Once your application is approved you will receive an email with instructions on how to submit payment (if applicable) electronically, and how to print a receipt and temporary bus pass from the comfort of your own home. From the email you receive, you may go to <https://www.ezschooldpay.com> to submit payment online. Once you create an account and add your students the Online Store link will display the bus fee amount. An EZSchoolPay how-to guide is at <https://www.luhsd.net/> Select the 3 lines beneath the SCHOOLS drop-down. Click on Welcome to the LUHSD Department Page. On the left select Transportation Services.

You may qualify for free transportation. The Free Transportation Qualification Schedule is below.

If your student qualifies for **Special Education** transportation please do not submit an application online. Please contact your school district to apply.

General education students are NOT eligible for transportation if they are attending a school other than their home school, are within walking distance (K-8 = 1 mile radius) or are attending pm kindergarten.

BUS RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Obey the authority of the bus driver.
2. Be at the bus stop 10 minutes before pick-up time.
3. Remain seated.
4. If bus is equipped with seat belts, belt must be worn at all times.
5. Keep hands and head inside the bus at all times.
6. Be courteous to others. No inappropriate language.
7. Students are to remain quiet at railroad crossings.
8. No glass, hazardous material, skateboards, roller blades weapons, radios, laser pointers or balls allowed on the bus.
9. No animals, reptiles or insects allowed on the bus.
10. Do not destroy property; Parent/Guardian will be held financially responsible.
11. Students will be escorted by driver only.
12. Student's behavior is to be orderly before, during and after bus arrival.
13. No eating, drinking, gum or smoking on the bus.
14. No loud distracting noises.
15. Bus pass must be presented to driver upon request. Bus pass may not be used by any other student.
16. Students must use assigned bus stop.
17. Students must NOT approach bus after it leaves stop.

FREE TRANSPORTATION QUALIFICATION SCHEDULE

When applying for free transportation, income verification must be attached. Below are the eligible forms of verification of income.

- 3 most recent pay stubs – valid for 1 quarter
- 3 most recent Social Security payments – valid for 1 quarter
- Recent proof of Welfare/AFDC/Unemployment – valid for 1 quarter
- Recent proof of child support – valid for 1 quarter
- Recent proof of spousal support – valid for 1 quarter
- Recent proof of pension or retirement – valid for 1 quarter
- Recent proof of disability benefits – valid for 1 quarter
- Free or reduced lunch approval letter (after submitting an application to the district the student attends school in). – valid for entire school year

Recent means within the last 30 days.
