MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

March 9, 2019

For the 2019-20 school year, ARTICLE X, Section 12 is amended to read:

Section 12 - Special Education Teachers

In order to fulfill their professional duties with their special education case load, the District shall provide up to five (5) days of release time to elementary special education teachers, and substitutes will be provided. The District shall provide up to three (3) six (6) days of release time to middle school and up to one (1) day to high school special education teachers. Substitutes will be provided. This release time shall be taken in half or whole day increments. This release time cannot be scheduled to conflict with staff, team or department meetings. The teacher will plan on-site release time to address special education case load. The release time will be scheduled with reasonable notice to and mutual agreement of the site administrator.

Each elementary school site will receive additional classified support of 20 - 40 hours a year, based on the ratio of special education teachers. The special education teachers at that site can utilize those extra support staff hours for IEPs and special education-related support.
