



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Unemployment Insurance Benefits

Unemployment Insurance Facts

Temporary income for eligible workers who lose their job through no fault of their own.

- File your claim the first week you lose your job. The first week is an unpaid waiting week.
- If eligible, your first payment will generally be made 2 3 weeks from when your claim is completed and processed.
- A claim is valid for 1 year; up to 26 weeks of regular UI benefits
- Certify weekly for each weekly benefit payment.



Unemployment Insurance Facts

- Minimum benefit rate is \$136 per week; maximum \$504.
- Based on prior earnings in a 'base period'; an 18 month look back.
- Unemployment Insurance benefits are taxable!
 - 10% for federal tax and 2.5% for state tax
 - You may choose to have taxes withheld



INFORMATION NEEDED TO APPLY FOR UI BENEFITS

Before you file a new claim for benefits, be sure to have all of the following information:

- **✓** NYS driver's license or Motor Vehicle ID card number (if you have either one).
- ✓ Alien Registration card number (if you are not a U.S. Citizen and have a card).
- Complete mailing address and zip code.
- ✓ A phone number where we can reach you.
- Names and addresses of all employers for the last 18 months, including those in other states.
- Employer Registration Number (ERN) or Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN) of your most recent employer (FEIN is on your W-2 forms).
- ✓ Copies of forms SF8 and SF50, if you were a federal employee.
- ✓ Most recent separation form (DD 214), for military service.

Important: Don't file now - File your claim during the first week you are unemployed.



What to Expect After You File a Claim

- Review your Monetary Determination and Claimant Handbook
- Check your mail and email, respond to any questionnaires, online forms, or phone calls from the Department of Labor right away to prevent delays in your payments.
- Certify for Benefits Each Week
 - 1. Online: <u>labor.ny.gov/signin</u>, select "Unemployment Services", then choose "Claim weekly benefits", <u>or</u>
 - 2. By phone: Call 1-888-581-5812
 - Hours: 24 hours a day, 7 days a week




