Dear Parents and Guardians of Incoming 6th Grade Students:

We hope the following information concerning health services will be helpful to you and your student. Health services will be provided in accordance with the New Jersey Department of Health and the New Jersey Department of Education recommendations.

**Screenings**

All students in grades 6-8 are screened annually for height, weight and blood pressure. Vision screening is done annually for students in grades 6 and 8. Hearing and scoliosis screening is done annually for students in grade 7.

**Medication**

It is school policy that students are not allowed to carry medication at school. The only students permitted to carry medication at school are those with written Health Plans to use inhalers, Diabetes medication and Epinephrine Auto injectors. All other prescription medications and over the counter medications must have written orders by a doctor, on the district medication form. The medication form needs to be signed by the doctor and parent. (Please refer to our district medication policy and medication form, that can be downloaded on our district webpage).

All Health Plans and Medication Forms must be updated every new school year.

**First Aid and Illness**

Nurses are always available during the school day to provide care and first aid to students with injuries and for those not feeling well. Please do not send your student to school if they are not feeling well. Prevention of the spread of communicable diseases in school where a large number of students gather, requires cooperation between home and school.

It is very important that we have current phone numbers and emergency contact information in Real Time, in the event we need to reach you.

We appreciate your updating the Health Office with student injuries that occur in school or out of school, any illnesses or change in health status.

**Immunizations**

All incoming 6th grade students are required to have a current Tdap and Meningitis vaccine. If your child is entering our school district for the first time please provide current immunization records and a current physical form from your Healthcare Provider.

**Sports Physicals**

Your student will need to have a current sports physical on file, completed within 365 days of the start of a sports season, to participate. Sports physicals are required for both Intramural and Intramural sports activities. Please see our district Athletic webpage to register your student and to download sports physical forms. Please submit all sport forms to the Health Office.
