Guardianship	Contact a guardianship attorney. For more information call Brown County Aging & Disability Resource Center @ 448-4300.	Apply up to 6 months before turning 18.
Long-Term Care Funding And Functional Screen	Brown County Aging and Disability Resource Center @ 448-4300.	Apply for Functional Screen at 17 years, 9 months. You will need a qualifying full scale IQ on file. Make sure you meet 3 of 6 criteria needs on the Functional Screen: Self Care, Physical Mobility, Learning (memory), Understanding use of Language (directions), Self-Direction (vocational support/decision making), Capacity of Independent Living.
Obtain a Disability Determination	Social Security Office @ 433-3904. www.socialsecurity.gov or Medical Assistance (comes automatically with SSI)	Apply on or after 18 th birthday. Apply 1 month after 18 th birthday unless birthday falls on the 1 st of the month, then apply that month. Start gathering required information before age 18 to speed up the process. After age 18 when SSI starts. If a student receives SSI benefits prior to 18, they also receive MA. Students need to reapply for SSI as an adult to continue MA. If student does not receive MA, student will need to apply separately @ 448-6095.
Adult Psychological Evaluation with Full Scale IQ	Please ask questions at the IEP to see if there is a adult score on file or when your district will need to retest.	IQ score below 75 is needed prior to applying for SSI, for eligibility for adult service funding like DVR/Community Employment Support, long term funding from Brown County Human Services for Day and Work Service Programs, and for anyone who will work at ASPIRO.
Choosing Your Adult Service Provider	Contact Brown County Human Services for more info @ 448-6061 or contact your Brown County Case Manager.	To help with transition planning, agency tours should be done 2 years prior to graduation. Decision for adult service provider should be made with the Brown County Case Worker. Options for Day Services, Pre-Vocational Work Services, and Supported Employment Services
Apply for DVR (not always necessary)	http://dwd.wisconsin.gov/dvr/ 1-800-228-2637	Graduating at 18 and No Need for Supported Employment: Apply at end of Junior year Graduating at 21 and Need for Supported Employment: Apply year before graduating
