

Safeguarding at Oakley School

Information for Primary Parents

Welcome to Oakley School. Your child's safety and wellbeing are at the heart of everything we do. This leaflet outlines how we keep children safe and how we work in partnership with families to ensure every child feels secure, supported, and ready to learn.

What is Safeguarding?

Safeguarding means:

- Protecting children from harm
- Promoting their health and wellbeing
- Ensuring they grow up in a safe and caring environment


Every member of our staff team is committed to this responsibility.


Who to Talk To

We have specially trained staff who lead on safeguarding:

- Designated Safeguarding Lead for our whole school (DSL): Mr Mike Few
- Deputy DSL(s): Mrs Grace Welbourne (Assistant Headteacher), Mrs Cassie Shirley (Deputy Headteacher), Mrs Beccy Kelsall-Gooch (SENDCo)

You can speak to any member of staff if you have concerns, and they will direct you to the right person.

Keeping Our School Site Safe

- The school site is secure during the day.
- All visitors must sign in and wear an ID badge.
- Children are always supervised by staff.

Collection Procedures

- Children must be collected by a named adult.
- If there is a change to who's collecting, please inform us in advance either by informing class teacher or telephoning the school office
- We will not release a child to an unfamiliar person without your permission. This will then result in us telephoning you to confirm collection.

Teaching Children to Stay Safe

Through our daily routines and curriculum (like PSHE, The Taking Care Project (Protective Behaviours Scheme) and NSPCC's PANTS rules), we teach children:

- To talk about their feelings

Be the best you can be!

- Know who their safe, trusted adults are (Network Hand)
- To understand their right to feel safe
- Who to speak to if they need help

What We Look Out For

Staff are highly trained to notice signs that something might not be right, including:

- Unexplained injuries or frequent absences
- Behaviour changes
- Family difficulties or concerns

We may talk to you or seek advice from external professionals if we have concerns—always in the best interests of your child.

Working Together

We believe safeguarding works best when schools and families work closely. If you ever have a worry about your child or another child, please speak to us.


