Today marked the return of Paterson Public Schools' graduations since Hinchliffe Stadium was closed in 1996. Graduates of the Class of 2023 took to the field to receive their high school diplomas in two separate ceremonies. For the morning ceremony that started at 9:00 A.M. the students of John F. Kennedy HS, International HS, and the S.T.A.R.S./T.I.E.S. program gathered under cloudy skies. There would be showers several times throughout the ceremony, but continued as planned. The afternoon ceremony that started at 12:30 P.M. would see better weather; occasionally having the sun shine through. The schools that took part were Eastside HS, Paterson STEAM, HS, Rosa Parks HS, Paterson P-TECH HS.
