ISD 192 SPECIFIC POLICIES

1020 ADDRESSING SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER VIOLATIONS

I. PURPOSE

- A. The Board and each of its members are committed to faithful compliance with the provisions of the Board's policies.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

The Board recognizes that its failure to deal with violations of its policies and board member misconduct risks the loss of public confidence in the Board's ability to govern effectively. Therefore, in the event of a member's violation of policy, or other forms of misconduct, the Board shall address the issue by using the following steps.

- A. Conversation in a private setting between the offending member and the School Board Chair or other individual member; such conversation will be reported to the balance of the Board.
- B. Discussion in a public meeting between the offending member and the full School Board.
- C. Public censure, by simple majority vote, of the offending member of the School Board, as well as removal from committees and leadership positions, to which the member has been appointed or elected.
- D. Removal from the School Board for proper cause by a concurrent vote of at least four members. The board member to be removed will be duly notified of the time and place of the meeting for which the vote is to be taken, and for the reasons for the proposed remove. The Board member will be given an opportunity to be heard in defense against the removal.

Most board member issues and situations are intended to fall into Category A. Category B, C, and D are intended for extreme and/or repeated instances of violations where Category A has not resulted in a change in member behaviors.
