Approval of Minutes	The minutes were not approved due to quorum requirements not being met (several members came in late).
Budget Status Report	There was no discussion on the report, as there were no changes from last month.
	Nicole summarized and reviewed the Norms and Agreements that were discussed at the last meeting (being on time, notifying Nicole if you are going to miss the meeting, etc.)
Summary of Professional Learning	<p>In response to a request at the last meeting, Nicole presented data on both last years fall workshops and collegial circles and those currently being offered. The data was reviewed by the group and a few general questions were asked and answered.</p> <p>Nicole pointed out that the SEL Series and some tech workshops continue to be popular (but not as well attended as in the summer), and that fall is not a popular time for PD, as teachers are busy with the beginning of the school year.</p> <p>A discussion took place about AI in general and our workshop offerings: how AI can be used as an efficiency tool for teachers, how to teach students to use it properly, and how we best roll it out. This topic is being addressed across the district and a district policy is currently being formulated. This is a popular topic for further professional development.</p>
