



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### **Budget and Resource Allocation**



The number one priority is to build and upgrade all items budgeted on the previous slide, as those are what were approved by the voters when this bond passed in November of 2024.

If there are funds left over in contingency at end of the bond program - a few potential projects are:

Windsor Window Shade Removal.....TBD

The District is also pursuing a grant with the Washington State Department of Commerce. The initial application for the Grant was not awarded, but, there is a new round in September that the District will pursue. If that grant comesthrough there will be \$632K dedicated to retrofitting all of the remaining ED light fixtures at CHS, which will positively impact the learning environment reduce energy costs, and maintenance osts

#### **Unforeseen Conditions**

- > Asphaltthicknessat the track rangedfrom 3"-6" in thickness
- ➤ Asphaltthicknessat the homesidebleachers anged from 3"-10"+ in thickness
  - > Asphaltwasscheduledo be 3", per the originalplansThis is due to the original contractor not properly prepping prior to paving
- > Asphaltpavingwasfound below the asphaltat the home side bleachers This is below subgrade is in good condition, thus the subsurface asphaltwas left in place
- ➤ Three (3) car sizedfootingshavebeenfound on site they appear to be old power pole footings One of the three (3) footingshad to be removed by the Purple Pipe Project contractor to continue their run of the purple pipe.
