Minutes

Attendance: President Evans and Board Clerk Shanai Lee.

President Evans opened the hearing at 5:45 p.m.

President Evans stated that Education Law subdivision 2857(1) and regulations of the Commissioner of Education 8 N.Y.C.R.R. § 119.4 require the Board to conduct a public hearing within 30 days of receipt of notice of an application for a new charter school.

President Evans explained that the Rochester Career Mentoring Charter School has filed an application with the New York State Board of Regents. The proposed school is expected to open in September 2011 with an estimated enrollment of 140 students in 9th and 10th grade in the first year. Enrollment is anticipated to reach 280 students in 9th through 12th grade by the fifth year of operation. He then requested public input and questions regarding this school.
