

**ROC Achieve Charter School
Public Hearing
November 29, 2018
5:30 p.m.
Minutes**

Attendance: President Van Henri White, Commissioner Melanie Funchess and District Clerk Shanai Lee.

President White opened the hearing at 5:30 p.m.

President White stated that the Education Law subdivision 2857(1) and regulations of the Commissioner of Education 8 N.Y.C.R.R. § 119.4 require the Board to conduct a public hearing within 30 days of receipt of notice of an application for a new or revised charter school.

President White explained that the Board of Education of the Rochester City School District is conducting this public hearing to gather community input regarding the application for the renewal of the charter for ROC Achieve Charter School. He further explained that ROC Achieve Charter School currently serves approximately 420 students in grades 5-8, and estimates an enrollment of 400 students in these grade levels under the proposed charter renewal.

President White then requested public comment regarding the school.

No speakers were present.
