

**District-Wide Safety Plan Public Hearing**  
**November 21, 2019**  
**Minutes**

**Attendance:** Vice President Cynthia Elliott and District Clerk Marisol O. Ramos-Lopez.

Vice President Elliott opened the hearing at 5:36 p.m.

District Clerk Ramos-Lopez noted that the Education Law subdivision Section 155.17 School safety plans 2857(1) require the Board to conduct a public hearing for a comprehensive district-wide school safety plan and building-level emergency response plans regarding crisis intervention and emergency response and management, Such plans shall be developed by a district-wide school safety team and a building-level emergency response team, as such terms are defined in subdivision (b) of this section, and shall be in a form developed by the commissioner in consultation with the Division of Criminal Justice Services, the superintendent of the State Police and any other appropriate State agencies. Each district-wide school safety plan and building-level emergency response plan shall be reviewed by the appropriate school safety team on at least an annual basis, and updated as needed.

Vice President Elliott explained that the Board of Education of the Rochester City School District is conducting this public hearing to gather community input regarding the District-Wide Safety Plan.

Vice President Elliott then requested public comment regarding the District-Wide Safety Plan.

No speakers were present.
