Hearing aids should be kept safe, clean and out of reach of little brothers and sisters. Make a sign to tape onto your hearing aid case or to put underneath it with your name on it using fancy, colorful writing. For example: <i>Jasmine's Hearing Aids</i>	Think about your teacher in school using the FM transmitter. Think about times that the FM has been on <b>mute</b> .
