1. Consider a Less Expensive Generic

Generics are just as effective as brand-name drugs but are often a fraction of the cost. They have the same active ingredients and go through the same U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) testing. If you are taking a brand drug, ask your provider if a generic alternative is appropriate.

2. Take Advantage of Convenient 90-Day Refills

Ask your prescriber if your maintenance medication can be filled every 90 days instead of every 30 days. Not only will you make fewer trips to the pharmacy, but you can also save money in many cases. Typically, 90-day refills can be filled either at your retail pharmacy or by mail order.* Check your plan details on Navitus' member portal or your plan's website.

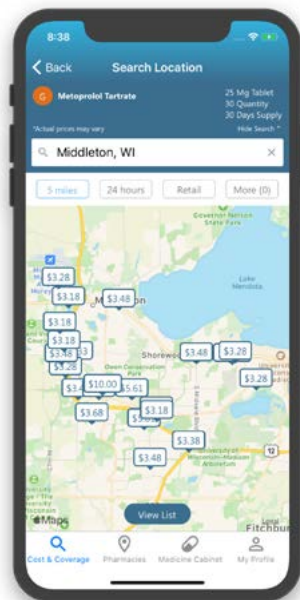


3. Ask About Tablet Splitting

You can save up to 50% on out-of-pocket costs for select medications by simply splitting them in half. Tablet splitting breaks a higher-strength drug tablet in half to deliver the same prescribed dose as a smaller tablet. This means you'll get the exact same drug and dosage, but you save money by paying for fewer tablets. Not all pills can be split, so talk to your prescriber or pharmacist before you consider splitting your pills.
