

## The Four Questions of the Extracurricular Participant

1. **Did I fail any classes for the first nine weeks six week IPR or for any of the nine weeks report cards?**

Answer: No. Then student can continue to participate.

Yes. Then go to question #2.

2. **When do I become ineligible?**

Answer: The failing student becomes ineligible at the end of the school day, seven calendar days from the day the first nine weeks six week IPR or when a nine week grading period has ended.

3. **What do I have to do to become eligible?**

Answer: The ineligible student must be passing all classes on the day ending the three or six week period (IPR date) or the nine week grading period.

4. **When would I be eligible?**

Answer: If student is passing all classes on the specified mid nine weeks date or the end of the nine week grading period, then that student becomes eligible seven calendar days from that date.
