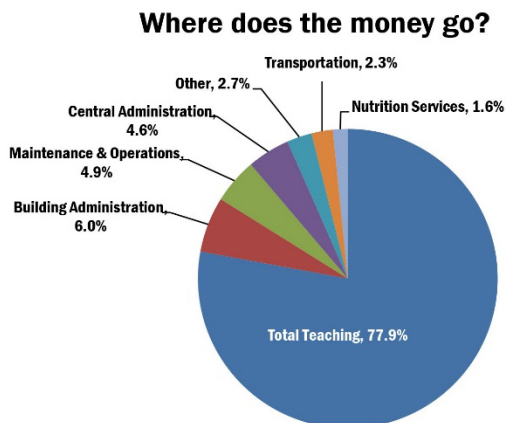
School Description

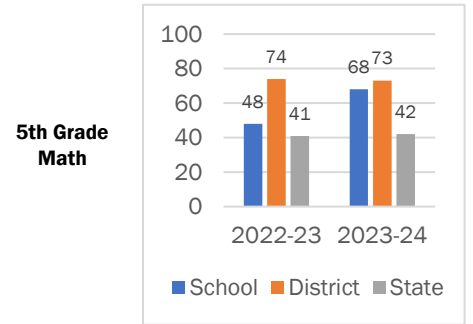
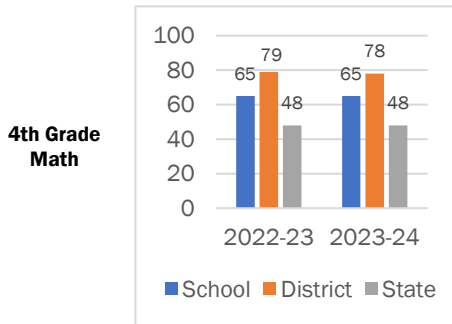
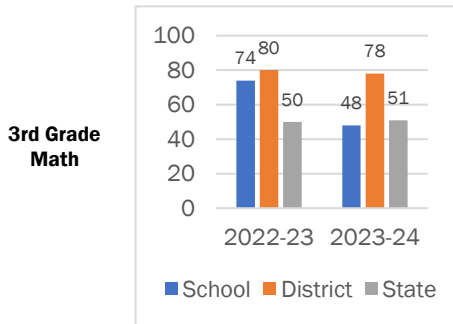
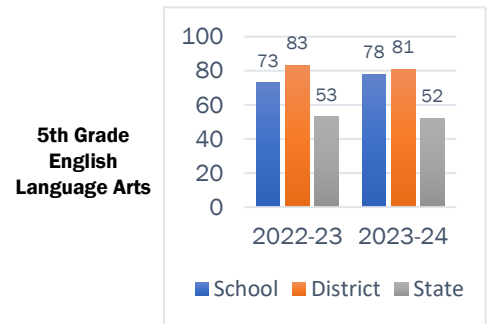
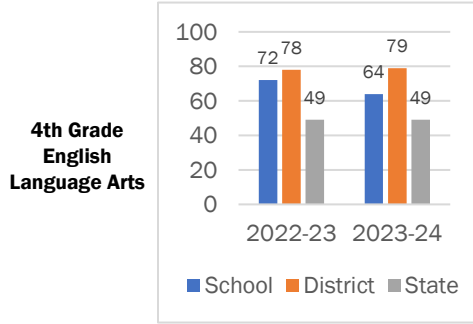
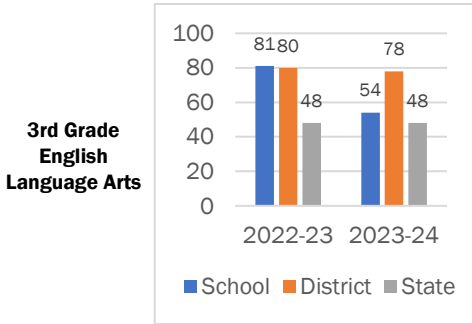
2023-24 School Goals

Academic goals were determined from an in-depth building-wide analysis process.

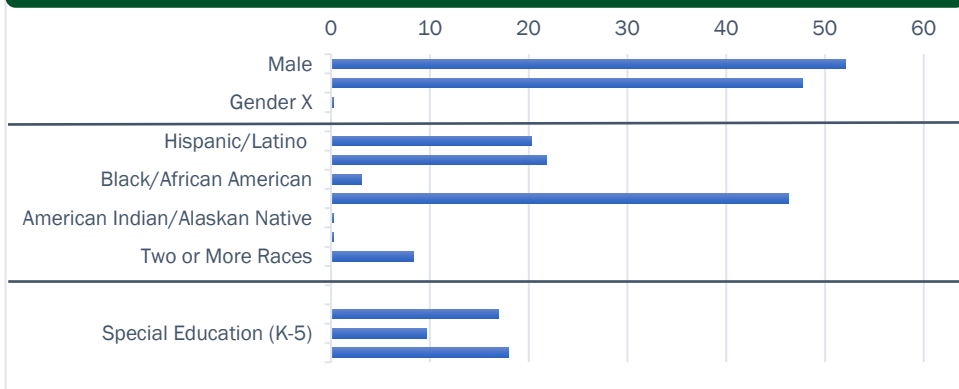
- **English Language Arts/Literacy:**
100% of Bell students will show growth as determined by the FastBridge Group Growth report.
- **Math:**
100% of 4th and 5th Grade students will show growth in "Math Automaticity" as measured by attaining their end of year goal on the FastBridge CBMMath Group Growth Report.
- **Social/Emotional Learning:**
Increase the percent of Bell 3rd through 5th graders who report the ability to identify and describe the emotions they are feeling from 50% to 65%, as measured by the Social Awareness indicator on the student Panorama survey.
