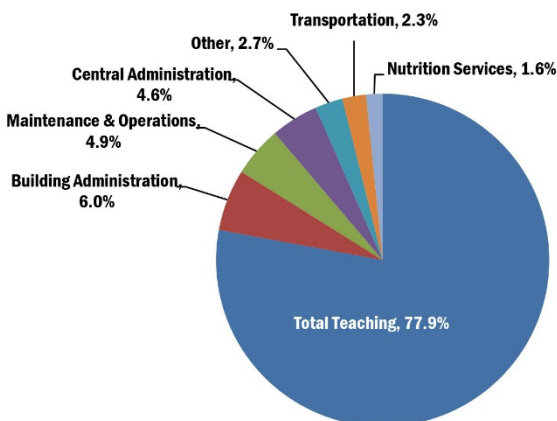
2023-24 School Goals

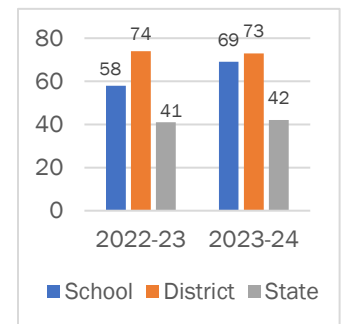

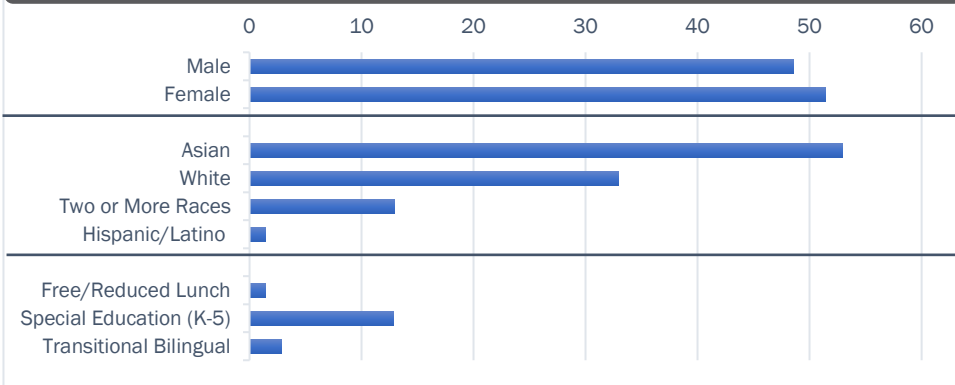


State Assessment Results
