

REASSESSMENT

A reassessment may be granted when a learner has not yet met proficiency and after reflection, they determine would like to request an opportunity for additional time and/or opportunities to learn. A request is made with evidence of additional learning or review in collaboration with the learner's educator. A request may be made for components within the process of a lengthy performance assessment, but not for the entire performance. A request will be honored any time prior to the final week of the grading period or within the educator's set deadline. If the learner has not yet gotten feedback a temporary "insufficient evidence" score may be awarded while the reassessment is completed.

Guidelines for what needs to be included in a learner request for a reassessment:

The learner must:

- Show evidence of taking the initiative (agency) to complete additional learning, which may include unfinished assignments or tasks
- Have a plan of action
- Commit to the plan
- Follow through on the plan (resilience)
- Complete all steps within the agreed upon timeframe (responsibility)
