



# MOUNT SPOKANE HIGH SCHOOL

## 2023-2024 SCHOOL PROFILE

### THE COMMUNITY

The Mead School District is located in North Spokane County and serves 10,574 students in grades PK-12. The district currently consists of two comprehensive high schools, three middle schools, nine elementary schools, and two parent partnership schools, utilizing a K-5, 6-8, 9-12 and K-12 grade-level configuration. The Mead School District's 4-year on-time graduation rate is 90% for the Class of 2023.

### THE SCHOOL

Mt. Spokane High School is one of two comprehensive public high schools in the Mead School District, serving over 1,500 students in grades 9-12, with an average class size ratio of 21.6. The four-year graduation rate for students in the Class of 2023 was 91.5%. Mt. Spokane High School staffs 85 certificated teachers, with 80% holding a Master's Degree or higher, and the average years of teaching experience is 16.2 years. The school opened in the fall of 1997 and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 1999. Mt. Spokane renewed its accreditation in the fall of 2020 through the Washington Association of Educational Service Districts, and is accredited through 2026.

### THE CURRICULUM

The academic program at Mt. Spokane provides a six period day, 5 days a week. Students in the classes of 2021 and beyond are required to earn 24 credits for graduation and meet one of the Graduation Pathways outlined by the Washington Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction and [House Bill 1599](#).
