What is the Federal Program Review (FPM) ?

- Referred to as 'FPM' by staff
- RUSD receives categorical funding from the State and Federal government.
- Examples of categorical funding received:
 - Title I - Funds help close the achievement gap
 - Title III - Funds support English learners with improving English language skills

- Did the DELAC/ELAC receive training on their roles and responsibilities?

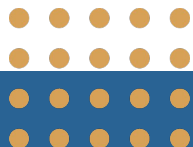
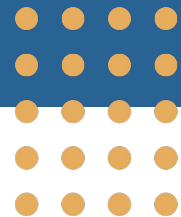

Sample FPM Questions (2)

- How have you been notified about the Uniform Complaint Procedures (UCP)?
¿Cómo se le ha notificado acerca de los Procedimientos Uniformes de Quejas (UCP)?
- How do teachers and the school communicate with you? Is language a barrier?
¿Cómo se comunican los maestros y la escuela con usted? ¿Es el idioma una barrera?
- What opportunities do you have to get involved with your child's school?
¿Qué oportunidades tiene usted para involucrarse con la escuela de su hijo?
- How do you know how your child is doing in school?
¿Cómo sabe cómo le va a su hijo en la escuela?
- What types of training/workshops have been offered to you?
¿Qué tipos de formación/talleres se le han ofrecido?
- What types of support, special programs, and services does your child participate in?
¿En qué tipos de apoyo, programas especiales y servicios participa su hijo?



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
