

## Fairfield Elementary School School Uniform Policy

Parents, please be mindful that students out of uniform may be **distractive** or **disruptive** to the learning process here at Fairfield Elementary School. **Any student violating this dress code will be considered insubordinate and dealt with according to the FCSD Code of Conduct.** School administrators have the final responsibility for interpretation and enforcement. School administrators may give permission for students to dress outside the parameters of the dress code guidelines on planned occasions, such as Jean Day, Spirit Day, and Incentive Day, etc. **Advance notice will be given to the students for such days.**

All students attending Fairfield Elementary School are required to wear a school uniform daily consisting of the following:

**\*Solid red, navy, or royal blue polo oxford shirt, solid khaki or navy bottoms!**

- Book bags- **No roller book bags are allowed, no lights or sounds**
- **No cell phones or electronic devices are allowed on or out during class**
- Pants (**boys and girls**)-solid khaki, solid Navy **(No Jeans, Leggings or Jeggings)**
- Pants are worn on the waist with no sagging or oversized styles
- Shorts (**boys and girls**) - solid khaki, solid navy
- **Skirts, Skorts (girls ONLY)**— solid khaki, solid navy
- Shorts, Skirts, Skorts, or Dresses are longer than a student's fingertips when arms are held at his or her side
- Appropriate blue jeans, pants, or shorts without holes, or rips. **(Friday's ONLY with school's spirit fundraiser t-shirts)**
- Jumper dress (girls **ONLY**) solid khaki, or solid navy
- Polo style dress (girls **ONLY**) solid red, solid royal blue, or solid navy (**must** have a collar)
- Oxford or polo style shirt (**long-sleeve or short-sleeve**) solid red, solid royal blue or navy
- Shirts **must** have a collar (**No tee shirt**)
- **Shoes— no lights or sounds**
- Shoes have closed toes and closed backs.
- **Backless shoes, crocs, slides, bubble slides, shoes with lights, or flip-flops are NOT allowed. No open-toe or backless sandals are allowed for safety reasons**

Parents, please help us to teach our students to follow the rules by ensuring that students wear the appropriate uniform to school each day.
