- <u>Purpose</u>: To bolster representation of Native voices and narratives from within Michigan, the Great Lakes, and North America
- <u>Selection Committee</u>: Book list was compiled by project directors, cohort teachers, secondary ELA chair, district library chairs, and a consultant with expertise in Indigenous history and literature.
