#### Accreditation

#### Admissions

Grace Jr/Sr High has approximately 335 students in grades 7-12. **Senior Class Size: 60**

2. Be submissive to the policies and procedures set forth by Grace Church and School.

#### Graduation Requirements

- A total of 270 units with a minimum GPA of 2.0 are required for Grace High School graduation.
- Grace Jr/Sr High School assigns 5 units of credit per course each semester.
- 12<sup>th</sup> grade students must successfully complete the following units to receive a diploma from GBS: Bible (40), English (40), Mathematics (30), Social Sciences (35), Science (30), Foreign Language (20), P.E (10), Visual Performing Art (10), Expository Composition (5) and Critical Thinking & Composition (5), Elective Units (45).
