

# Miller Fine Arts Magnet Middle School **DRESS CODE** 2025-2026



#### STUDENTS MAY WEAR THE FOLLOWING:

#### **PANTS OR BOTTOMS:**

- Plain khaki, black, or navy pants; plain blue jeans or plain khaki, black, or navy skirts. (No colored jeans ex: pink, green, royal blue)
- Black or blue jeans are allowed daily. However, jeans must NOT have rips or frays or designed with rips or frays.
- No sweatpants, cargo pants, camo pants, athletic joggers, athletic (basketball)shorts, tennis/athletic skirts, dry-fit pants, leather pants, jeggings, leggings, biker shorts, or yoga pants. (No oversized pants, jorts, or pants with pockets on the sides that are trending)
- Shorts, skirts, dresses, and skorts must be no shorter than two (2) inches above the knee at all points front, back, and sides. Additionally, these garments must be at least as long as the tips of the student's fingers when the arms are fully extended at their sides. Skirts may not contain any slits, splits, or openings. Polo shirt dresses and trending tennis skirts are NOT permitted.
- Shorts/Skirts/pants must be in the dress code colors: black or blue jean, plain khaki, black, or navy.
- Pants must be of an appropriate size, worn as designed, and of ankle length. Sagging pants or pants designed to be worn below the top of the hip bone are NOT allowed.
- Pants/shorts/skirts must be appropriate, not excessively tight or revealing undergarments.
- Overalls, rompers, and jumpsuits are not allowed.
- Belts required if you have belt loops (adjustable waistbands are acceptable).

#### SHIRTS/TOPS:

- Only plain collared polo shirts in white, blue (navy or royal), light blue, gray, black, or yellow may be worn. Any logos on shirts, outerwear, or accessories must be no larger than the size of a quarter (approximately 1 inch in diameter).
- Polo shirts may be long-sleeved or short-sleeved. Sleeveless shirts are NOT allowed.
- School spirit T-shirts, sweatshirts, and sweaters are permitted.
- Plain white, navy, royal blue, or yellow sweatshirts and sweaters may be worn.
- All shirts must be appropriate and must not expose any part of the waist, hips, midriff, chest, or back. No crop tops, no tying shirts up, and no seethrough or low-cut tops allowed.
- Plain white undershirts or turtlenecks may be worn underneath polo shirts, school T-shirts, sweatshirts, or sweaters.

#### **OUTERWEAR GUIDELINES:**

- Only plain (no patterns, graphics, or stripes) white, blue (navy or royal), black, or yellow hoodies/ jackets are allowed. Official school jackets /hoodies will be available for purchase.
- Plain blue jean jackets are permitted but must be free of rips, frays, or embellishments.
- Only plain (no patterns, graphics, or stripes) white, blue (navy or royal), black, or yellow sweatshirts or hoodies are allowed. Official school hoodies will be available for purchase.
- Jackets with hoods or hoodies may not be worn inside the school building.
- Oversized coats/Bubble jackets are NOT allowed in the school building.
- · Lightweight, hoodless jackets are permitted for classroom wear.

#### **SHOES AND SOCKS**

- All shoes must have closed toes and closed heels. Slippers, flip-flops, slides, shoes with wheels, and Crocs are not allowed. Crocs in sports mode may be permitted only on special days designated and announced by the principal.
- Soft-soled shoes are allowed. Heels and stilettos are NOT permitted.
- Tennis shoes must be worn with appropriately sized shoelaces, and shoelaces must be tied at all times.
- Socks are required and must be worn daily.
- Socks should NOT be tucked into pants.

### **ACCESSORIES**

- Headwear such as hats, headscarves, wave caps, bonnets, hoods, bandanas, and edge control bands are NOT permitted.
- Fishnet/Dance hosiery may NOT be worn as a substitute for leggings.
- Gloves are not allowed to be worn inside the building.
- Facial piercings (including nose, lips, tongue, eyelid, etc.) are NOT allowed.
- Pants chains are NOT permitted on any garments.
- Band-Aids and pimple patches may NOT be worn for fashion purposes.
- Belts must NOT have oversized buckles.
- Jewelry: Only small gold or silver pendants, bracelets, and necklaces are allowed.
- Earrings must be no larger than a quarter, and multiple bracelets are not allowed.
- Female Purses/Bags must be no larger than 6"x9" (half the size of a standard sheet of paper).
- Purses and male crossbody bags must be stored in student lockers. Fanny packs are NOT permitted.
- Nonprescription glasses/ Smart eyewear, or sunglasses may NOT be worn inside the building. Only clear or mesh bookbags are allowed. Student lockers will be available to rent for a fee.
- Electronic Devices: Cell phones, Smartwatches, Smart eyewear, AirPods, headphones, and Bluetooth headsets are NOT allowed to be used during the instructional day (8:35 AM-4:05 PM). The school is NOT responsible for lost or stolen personal electronic devices.
- Sprays, lotions, and Vaseline-type products must follow travel-size guidelines. Full-size containers are NOT permitted.
- Handheld personal electronic fans are NOT permitted.

# **HAIR**

- Students' hair must be neat, clean, and well-groomed at all times.
- Unnatural hair colors are not allowed, except on designated spirit days approved by the principal. Prohibited hair colors include (but are not limited to): Shades of pink, purple, red, orange, blue, green, and yellow that is not a natural blonde
- Any hairstyle or hair accessory that may cause a disruption to the school environment is subject to review and may be prohibited at the principal's

### **What Miller students** ARE allowed to wear:



**Small Handbag** No larger than a half-sheet of paper



Clear/Mesh Bookbags



**Lightweight Jackets** 



**Polo Shirts** Any logos on shirts, outerwear, or accessories must be no larger than the size of a quarter.

**Blue Jean Jacket** Plain, no rips, holes, frays or embellishments



**Pants** Plain, no rips, holes. frays or embellishments



**Shorts** No more 1-2 inches above the knee. Not excessively tight or rolled up

1-2 inches above the knee.

## **What Miller students** are NOT allowed to wear:

Students are not permitted to wear excessively short or tight uniforms. Uniforms must NOT have rips or holes. All jeans with rips and frays worn on announed dress-downdays must NOT have skin showing. Please wear opaque leggings underneath. Fishnet hosiery should not be worn to school.

**Close Toe Shoes** 


No overalls, jumpsuits, NO jeans pants, shorts, or skirts with rips or frays. This includes polo dresses and short tennis skirts



No cargo pants, leather pants, or jeggings



No athletic pants, sweatpants, joggers, shorts, yoga pants, biker shorts, or leggings.



No facial piercing such as the nose, lips, tongue, eyelid, etc. are allowed. This includes pimple patches.



No sleeveless, crop tops, midriffs, lowcut, see-through or mesh shirts. This includes tying up shirts.



No lightweight jackets patterns, or stripes. No **Red Hoodies** 



No un-natural hair dyed shades of pink, shades of purple, shades of red, shades of orange, yellow that is not blonde, shades of blue, or shades of green.



No hats, head scarves, wave caps, do rags, bonnets, berets, pants chains, hoods, or bandanas.



No slippers, flip flops, shoes with wheels, slides, Crocs, stilettos. sunglasses **Fanny Packs,** oversized purses, or bags
