

Dear families,

We would like to share information about the two general education math course options available for sixth grade: **Math 6** and **Accelerated Math 6**. Students will automatically be placed in **Math 6**. However, families may choose to self-select their child into **Accelerated Math 6**, after considering the information provided below.

Course descriptions

- **Math 6:** Students learn the 6th grade Michigan Math Standards.
- **Accelerated Math 6:** Students learn the 7th grade Michigan Math Standards with supplements of 6th grade standards when needed.

The [math learning pathways](#) document shows the future math courses students can take based on their placement in either Math 6 or Accelerated Math 6.

Important Considerations for Accelerated Math 6

Please be aware that Accelerated Math 6 is a more rigorous course, covering higher-level math concepts. This may require students to dedicate additional time and effort to succeed. It's possible that students in this course may receive grades that are lower than what they typically earn, especially as they adjust to the more challenging content. To be prepared to learn 7th grade math concepts, students must have fully mastered the 5th grade standards.

To be successful in Accelerated Math 6, students need to have mastered the following elementary concepts:

- Fluency with multiplication facts up to 12
- Traditional algorithm for multiplying whole numbers
- Place value and rounding
- Add and subtract decimals
- Simplify fractions
- Convert between mixed numbers and fractions
- Add, subtract, multiply fractions and mixed numbers
- Area of rectangles and perimeters of polygons

Please note that teachers will not be expected to reteach 5th grade content or provide extensive individual tutoring. Students who opt for Accelerated Math 6 should already be confident in these foundational skills.

Suggested Criteria

We have included criteria below to help families determine if Accelerated Math 6 is the right choice for their child. Families who are considering Accelerated Math 6 should complete the table below using their child's assessment scores and the [disposition inventory](#) scores. Students ready for Accelerated Math 6 should be scoring at the levels indicated in the table.

If, after reviewing this information, you determine that **Math 6** is the most appropriate placement for your child, no further action is required, and your child will be automatically enrolled in Math 6.

If you believe **Accelerated Math 6** is the best fit for your child, please contact your child's counselor with their scores from the table above. Once this information is provided, the counselor will ensure your child is enrolled in Accelerated Math 6 when scheduling their classes.
