




A Warm Welcome to New and Returning Families to EASD's 2019-2020 School Year!

...Off to a Great Start !!!




The Integrated English class is co-taught by Mrs. Meral and Miss Ely. Their first project required students to tell about their families.




Working Hard!

They had a great time using technology while also learning about some great Americans!




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




Re-Telling a Classic Story Can Be fun!!!



As a culminating activity, students read another modern day Cinderella story and retold it using their CLIPS app. **All the Cinderella characters are MEN!**






