2022 Capital Levy Repurposing of Funds – Tow-Yick/Turney

ACTION TO BE TAKEN: **I move the Board adopt Resolution 1234, reversing the provisions of Resolution 1222 and reaffirming the original intent of the 2022 Capital Levy in the amount of \$44,000,000 to construct a new comprehensive high school.**

Voters in the Issaquah School District approved a \$141,390,000 four-year capital levy on April 26, 2022, to construct, renovate, improve, and undertake critical repairs and expansion of new and existing facilities and improvements to technology equipment and training for safety, security, and efficiency.

A portion of the levy in the amount of \$44,000,000 was originally intended for the construction of a new comprehensive high school to address enrollment growth and improve educational opportunities. Resolution 1222, adopted on May 23, 2024, redirected these funds to other projects, including constructing secure vestibules, acquiring and equipping an early learning center, purchasing land for transportation facilities, and upgrading fire systems district-wide.

Resolution 1234 reverses this redirection, reaffirming the voters’ original intent for the 2022 Capital Levy. The funds will be applied to the construction of a new comprehensive high school, ensuring the district addresses long-term capacity needs and aligns with community expectations.
