NKC SCHOOLS TRACK ATHLETES FINISH STRONG AT STATE

The North Kansas City School District sent more than a dozen student athletes from across the district to compete at the state championship in Jefferson City this spring. Not only did many athletes set school records, but Aryn Lanier-Collier of Winnetonka High School set the state record in Girls 300 Meter Hurdles! Lanier-Collier's accomplishment is monumental. Overall, this year's track and field athletes performed well.

Winnetonka's state appearance was dominated by two athletes, Aryn Lanier-Collier and Yandel Radillo. In Class 4, Lanier-Collier took first in Girls 100 Meter Hurdles in addition to setting a new state record in Girls 300 Meter Hurdles with a time of 41.68. She also took 7th in Girls 200 Meters. The other dominant athlete, Yandel Radillo, placed first in the 100 Meter Para and the 200 Meter Para, making him an All-State para-athlete. Additionally, Joey Marsh from Winnetonka took 7th in Boys 400 Meters.

Staley High School brought home many awards in Class 5. Robert Collins Jr. won first in 100 Meters, with a time of 10.55; and placed second in Boys 200 Meters. The Boys took fifth overall, and the Girls placed 15th. Jeremiah Kelley placed second in Boys 110 Meter Hurdles. Both Staley's Girls and Boys 4x200 hurdle relay placed at state. The Girls took third, and the Boys took second. Other notable Staley accomplishments include:
