Directions for logging into Clever @home

### My Path on iReady

Students will have access to iReady through late July. Continue to have your child meet their 45 minute per week goal. Log in to iReady through Clever.

### Practice Math Facts

Learning math facts frees up your child's brain power for tougher problems. It makes them quicker and more accurate at math. Students in incoming Grade 2 - 6 have access to Reflex Math to assist in practicing addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division facts.

Directions: Students can log in through Clever (June - July) or log-in to [www.reflexmath.com](http://www.reflexmath.com) (August). Students need their previous teachers username and their NP password.

### Have FUN!

Play math games such as board games and card games helps students think strategically and mathematically. Cooking together also promotes learning: Fractions, measuring, and following recipes. Make math yummy! Explore the world with math: Shapes in nature, estimating distances, budgeting for a trip - Math is everywhere!

1. Download the Clever and iReady App.
2. Open the Clever App
3. Verify that you are signing into New Providence School District.
4. Choose Google Login and sign in using your student NPSD Google account
5. Choose iReady

1. Go to <https://clever.com/in/npsdnj>
2. Verify that you are signing into New Providence School District.
3. Choose Google Login and sign in using your student NPSD Google account
4. Choose iReady

#### Logging into Clever from an Android tablet.

1. Open the Chrome web browser.
2. Follow the laptop directions above.
3. Tap the three vertical dots in the top right-hand corner and choose "Desktop site." (Watch this [30-second video](#) for a visual example).
