Health & Sports Physical Info.

- Any medical supplies needed for the upcoming 2025-26 school year such as prescription meds, Epi-pens, inhalers, etc. will need to have a Medical Action Plan or Medication Authorization form on file at the school. Updated MAPS are REQUIRED each new school year and must have the physician signature on the form. Please bring the signed and completed MAP form together with any medications to the main office in August during registration. Click HERE for forms posted on the district website under Families-Community--Health & Wellness.
- Athletic Physicals: <u>Click HERE</u> for a blank 2025-26 Athletic Physical form if your student plans to participate in any middle school athletics.
 Physicals must be dated after April 15, 2025 and have a physician signature to be valid.
- All incoming 7th graders are required by the state
 of Michigan to be up to date on their
 immunizations or have a waiver on file. Click
 HERE for requirements, or call the Oakland
 County Health dept. or your health care provider.

Volunteer Forms

Anyone with plans to volunteer in any building during the school year needs to have an electronic I-Chat form submitted each year. See below for link and instructions.

New forms will need to be filled out each school year and are valid from July 1-June 30.

WORK PERMITS

Work permits are available in the VH main office. Most of our students will need the form for UNDER 16.

We need the birth certificate of the student in order to complete the work permit. Work permits are issued between the hours of 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Monday-Thursday.

After June 26 the VH office will be closed for the summer and permits will be available through the ADAMS HS counseling office.

Leaving Rochester?

If you are moving away or leaving RCS, please notify the school office: email us.

Students moving out of the district and to the IA do not keep their district-issued Chromebook. Please return their device, cover and charger to the Administration building, 52585 Dequindre Rd. No appointment needed.

In order to preserve your data in your district Google account once you are unenrolled, it must be transferred to a personal Google account of your choice. Show me how. You have until July 31 of the year you leave the district before your account is disabled and you will no longer be able to access your data.

ParentVue/StudentVue will also be disabled once the student is disenrolled. Please be sure to print or transfer report cards beforehand if you wish to keep them for your records.

RCS Summer Learning Program

Rochester Community Schools' Summer Learning Program information is now available online on the RCS District

Website. Courses offered for middle school students include:

- Middle School Health (non-credit), optional for students who will be in 8th grade next year and did not take Health/PE during the 7th grade year
- Algebra Prep (non-credit), for students currently in Pre-Algebra who may need to strengthen their math skills before taking Algebra next year (this is not a credit-earning class, but a skill-building class)
- CSI Science (non-credit), for students going into 8th or 9th grade next year
- MS Math Summer Program (non-credit), for reviewing key math concepts and building confidence
- Summer Music Theater (non-credit)
- Summer Innovation camp (non-credit)
- High School Physical Education (.5 credit), for incoming 9th graders only
- High School Health (.5 credit), for incoming 9th graders only
- High School World History Semester 1 (.5 credit) and Semester 2 (.5 credit), for incoming 9th graders only. Please note that BOTH the Semester 1 AND the Semester 2 courses are needed to fulfill graduation requirement.






