



## Welcome to White Settlement ISD!

White Settlement ISD will complete its 2022 bond program this fall, with the opening of the new Brewer Sixth Grade Center at the current Brewer Middle School site. Thanks to the support of the WSISD community, the district offers state-of-the-art facilities for its students and families. ## Bond Updates

- To enhance the safety of Brewer Middle School athletes, WSISD installed a synthetic turf field with a concussion pad in the BMS stadium. The turf enables WSISD to save money in water, fertilizer, maintenance and upkeep. The project also included the removal of the old visitor bleachers and new visitor stands that will accommodate 400 fans.
- WSISD also replaced the nearly 30-year-old BMS track and the original turf in the indoor workout facility. The track will be finished in mid-July.
- WSISD abated and demolished the Operations Building on Gibbs Street, the former site of MESA High School/DAEP and the original Brewer Middle School. The building and grass fields will be excavated and used as a future school site, if needed.

The district solicited bids from multiple contractors to determine the expense of remodeling the existing building versus building a new Operations facility. The most cost-effective option for WSISD was to demolish the building due to structural engineering issues with the original construction and age of the building.

A new, 12,000 square-foot metal building will be constructed at the location to house the Operations Department offices.

- An additional parking and driveway area will be installed at the West Early Learners Academy to alleviate traffic.

## West Early Learners Academy

The West Early Learners Academy opened in 2024 as part of the bond program. This innovative campus provides pre-kindergarten and kindergarten students with a solid foundation in early literacy and math, also offering the Dual Language program. Cub Creek Town engages young learners in real-world scenarios through imaginative play areas that include a bank, grocery store, hospital, restaurant, fire station, and construction site!

The walls and ceilings are covered with mountains, waterfalls, forests and animals throughout the world, and students earn opportunities to slide from the second floor when they excel in their behavior, academics, etc.

## Liberty Elementary

Students attend PE, music, STEAM and computer class daily, and Liberty offers the Dual Language program, enabling students to receive instruction in both English and Spanish every other week.

A new gym and expanded cafeteria will open at Liberty Elementary this fall as part of the bond.



## Fine Arts Academy at Tannahill

The Fine Arts Academy will relocate to the former Tannahill Intermediate site this fall. The first through fifth grade campus will expand to serve approximately 500 students. FAA first through fourth grade students attend music, art or drama every day, and fifth graders can choose electives such as band, art, choir, theatre and media/graphic arts as well as dance as their PE course. This year, the school will also offer the Dual Language program for first graders.

New enrollees will be admitted based on attendance boundaries, open enrollment, and space availability from the district transfer list.





## North STEAM Academy

North STEAM Academy incorporates Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math into the curriculum. Students attend a daily Technology class as well as a STEAM block that reinforces concepts taught in the regular classroom to make learning fun and hands-on.


The campus offers a two-way dual language immersion program for both native Spanish and English speakers. Students receive content area instruction in both English and Spanish, with the goal of developing proficiency in both languages for listening, speaking, reading and writing.

## Brewer Sixth Grade Center & Brewer Middle School

White Settlement ISD will complete its 2022 bond program this fall, with the opening of the new Brewer Sixth Grade Center and competition gym at the current Brewer Middle School site,

The three-story Sixth Grade Center will accommodate all sixth graders in WSISD. All students will have six classes and a homeroom period daily, and they will begin the year in a Pre-Athletic/PE period. Students interested in athletics will transition to athletics with training that includes Strength and Conditioning, Weights, Cardio, etc., preparing them for competitive sports.

Students not enrolled in band will participate in 12-week Explore rotations to preview potential course selections for their future school years:

- Introduction to CTE - Students will be introduced to a variety of CTE pathways including Business and Industry, Public Service (i.e. Law Enforcement and Legal Studies) and STEM.
- Visual Arts - Students will build upon their artistic skills while exploring different mediums.
- Intro. to Fine Arts - Students will explore Music, Choir and Theatre.

Other bond improvements at BMS included the expansion of the band hall and fine arts area and a new cafetorium that accommodates 2,000 people.

## Career & Technical Education

The BHS CTE Department offers 12 different Career Clusters and 24 Programs of Study including Health Science, Culinary Arts, Ag Mechanics, Cosmetology and Barbering, Information Technology, and Engineering.

CTE students take a sequence of courses that may begin in middle school and continue in high school, preparing them for entry-level work in a career path. Every Program of Study provides students with the opportunity to earn Industry-Based Certifications or college credit. CTE students may participate in CTE Student Organizations and compete at the district, regional, state and national levels.

BHS offers multiple college-level Advanced Placement and Dual Credit courses, enabling students to earn college credit towards an associate's degree. Students can participate in a variety of award-winning athletic, fine arts, CTE and extra-curricular programs as well as clubs and organizations that foster the leadership skills of every student.



### Safety & Security

WSISD employs a police officer at every school, a Safety, Security and Emergency Management Director, and additional security guards at the high school and middle school. The Guardian program provides an added level of security; educators can receive extensive training to carry concealed firearms on school facilities alongside local law enforcement.
